Ricky Allen Dubey, 41, of Caseville, died suddenly, Thursday, Dec. 13, 2007 at Riverview Adult Foster Care Home in Grant Township of natural causes.

He was born Aug. 30, 1966 in Pigeon to John and Beverly (Scepanski) Dubey and grew up in Caseville. He was employed at MOCO in Caseville as an electrician until 1997 when he went on medical disability from injuries received in a motorcycle accident.
