

Do I REQUIRE DOT COMPLIANCE?

DOT Compliance IS Required	DOT Compliance is NOT Required
Vehicle is being used for commercial business.	Vehicle is not being used for commercial business.
Power Unit has a Manufacture Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) of 10,001 lbs or greater.	Power Unit has a Manufacture Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) of 10,000 lbs or less.
The driver or company is being compensated for services or transportation of goods.	The driver or company is not being compensated for services or transportation of goods.
If towing a trailer and the Manufacturer's [Add GVWR of Power Unit & GVWR of Trailer= GCWR] Combined Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GCWR) of all units is 10,001 lbs or greater.	If towing a trailer and the Gross Combined Weight Rating (GCWR) of all units is 10,000 lbs or less.
Vehicle is designed or used to transport more than 8 people (for compensation), including the driver.	Vehicle is designed or used to transport less than 8 people (for compensation), including the driver.
Vehicle is designed or used to transport more than 15 people (not for compensation), including the driver.	Vehicle is designed or used to transport less than 15 people (not for compensation), including the driver.
Vehicle is used to transport Hazardous Material (HazMat) in a quantity requiring placards.	Vehicle is not used to transport Hazardous Material (HazMat) in a quantity requiring placards.
