Thanks for your interest in becoming part of 2022-2023 Performing Team Company.

If you are attending this week simply for the technique and experience, we understand some of the following may or may not pertain to you. We are glad you are attending and hope your child has enjoyed it as well as learns a lot.

Being part of our Performing Team Company requires more time spent at the studio and more money paid toward competitions and costumes. Your monthly fees paid to the studio usually do not change by much although; there are workshops and extra classes that Team Members are asked and expected to attend. Team Members are also expected to attend our exhibitions and community events. A few things you will want to know in advance are listed below.

Make sure you have paid for the Boot Camp - \$100.00

This of course, is a requirement for being on a Team and must be paid on or before Thursday, August 11th. If you choose to only take the Boot Camp classes for fun and experience that is perfectly fine. You simply will not attend Auditions.

Register for Fall Classes - \$45.00. No later than Thursday, August 11th

Pay your Audition Fee - \$10.00. No later than Thursday, August 11th

Don't Worry! Being on a Team is so much fun and the students always love it – and the Auditions are simply for placement purposes.

Please make sure you have done the above items on the portal - this is our way of communication and also record keeping. All payments can be made in the studio or online.

The results will NOT be posted.

All REGISTERED students should make an appointment to discuss placements from audition and monthly fees. Sign up for consultation appointment must be made through the portal and remember no appointments should be made until your child is a registered student and all outstanding balances and past dues have been paid in full. Consultation fee is \$10.00 per student and can NOT be done over the phone or via email.

Appointments will be available to schedule beginning Friday, August 12. Appointments will take place Monday (8/15), Tuesday (8/16) & Thursday (8/17) from 4:00PM-7:00PM each day.

Any student who has chosen to do a competition solo or duet/trio must turn in the signed Solo, Duet, Trio Contract before choreography begins.

All classes will begin Tuesday, September 6th.

2022-2023 Performing Team Members Meeting will be Tuesday, October 25th @ 6:30pm.

You will receive all information regarding the upcoming competition season at this meeting. We will discuss dates, fees, fundraisers, extra practices and much more – you will be able to mark your calendars for the entire year at this point. If you have conflicts for the upcoming year that you are already aware of, please email them to us ASAP – it is not a guarantee to avoid all conflicts, although we promise to try. Prom Dates are the most important to know. All Team Members will be given an account plan that will be saved in our computer. You will be asked to make payments throughout the year to keep your account current. All prospective Team Members must pay at least \$100.00 on or before the day of the meeting. It is also a great idea to go ahead and begin paying on your account exceeding the \$100.00. We will attend at least two MANDATORY conventions, three MANDATORY competitions and one MANDATORY nationals (Showstopper Nationals Myrtle Beach: July 3-8, 2023). If you have any conflicted weekend dates, I need those ASAP. The dates and locations for conventions and our regional competitions will be announced at this meeting. Team Members should plan to dance the month of June with the week after recital completely off for break.
