

The big deal about being thankful FAITH VS. UNDERSTANDING in Luke 17:11-19

Today's account in Luke leaves many unanswered questions

- How did these ten lepers hear about Jesus?
- What were their hopes and expectations?
- Were they disappointed at being sent away?
- Was there dissention among the group before they realized they were being healed?

- How did the Samaritan leper become part of the group to begin with?
- Where were the priests to whom they were to appear, to be given clearance to rejoin their communities?
- What about the Samaritan leper? Where was his temple?
- Were Jesus' companions afraid when the Samaritan returned? Would WE be?

Today's Scripture reading is not a bit subtle about its message: God is alive and acting in our lives, leading us to wholeness in a God-centered life filled with faith. God is the healing and wholeness we seek. I wonder if the ten lepers ever thought through their request when they agreed to approach the Lord.

- Did they anticipate the changes that would come about? The tensions and struggles in reclaiming their lives?
- Did they know they would never be the same again? Do WE?
- When we pray "Thy will be done" are we prepared to live out the challenges God's will presents?

We do not need to understand the outpouring of God's love—which is good, since "God's ways are not our ways." But we need to walk by faith, trusting God's presence and purpose for our lives.

Medieval theologian Meister Eckhart offered this bit of wisdom, which it seems the Samaritan leper knew 2,000 years ago: "If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough." And so, let us say "Thank you," loudly and boldly, as if we had just been cured of our leprosy—because we have.

One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising Gos in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him - and he was a Samaritan.

Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."
