Mayor of the Town of Kremmling

The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to a four-year term. Term will commence at the first regular Board of Trustees meeting following the certification of the election

Four (4) Town Board of Trustees Vacancies

The three candidates receiving the highest number of votes are elected to the four-year terms. The candidate with the fourth highest number of votes will be elected to a two-year term, to complete the term of a recently vacated seat. These terms will commence at the first regular Board of Trustees meeting following the certification of the election.

Nomination Petitions:

Nomination Petition for Mayor or Trustee may be circulated starting January 4, 2022 and must be returned by January 24. The petitions are available at the Clerk's Office Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM - 4:30 PM.

Mail Ballot Election:

- The election will be conducted as a mail ballot election per the "Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965".
- Ballots will be mailed no later than March 21, 2022.
- Ballots must be received no later than April 5, 2022 by 7 PM. Ballots received after this time will not be counted.
- Secure drop-off locations will be at:
 - CSU Extension Hall at 210 11th Street (a 24-hour drop-off)
 - Kremmling Town Hall at 200 Eagle Avenue (during regular business hours Monday - Friday 7:30 AM - 4:30 PM)

Election Day:

Election Headquarters will be at Kremmling Town Hall. The poles will be open from 7 AM - 7 PM. Electors can register to vote up to and including the day of the election at the Grand County Clerk and Records office.
