The X-Ch-Christos in Greek or Christusin Latin means "Anointed". The C-S-Soter in Greek

or Salvator in Latin means "Saviour".

The A-Alpha which is the first letter of the Greek alphabet means "Beginning".

The W-Omega which is the last letter of the Greek alphabet means "End".

The letters P and X in the symbol were used by Constantine as his "Labarum" or "processional emblem" to proclaim Christ as Saviour and Victor over all.

The crown of thorns is a reference to the Passion and Christ's kingship.
