

# Burglars cut through Bronx jewelry store roof to steal \$100G in gems, cash: cops

A group of burglars bore through the roof of a Bronx jewelry store and made off with more than \$100,000 in gems and cash Tuesday, police said.

The crooks knocked out surveillance cameras before scaling a wall and then cutting a hole into the ceiling of Abbasi Jewelry on E. Fordham Rd. at Marion Ave. in Fordham Heights around 3 a.m., according to cops.

Once inside, they cut into a safe containing jewelry and cash.

Apparently unsatisfied with the hefty score, the burglars also snatched \$2,000 worth of perfume from the Deluxe Perfume Center, which shares a space with jewelry shop.

Employees said the bandits seemed to be familiar with the layout.
