- 10) A letter dated May 1, 2020, from Tracy Shevlin, Section Chief, Bureau of Environmental, Engineering & Permitting, NJDEP, to the Authority, enclosing a Treatment Works Application Approval for the Oxford Area WWTP UV System. (Hearings to be conducted by way of Zoom.)

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco summarized the March 31, 2020 financial report. There is nothing unusual to report; everything is going along as planned. Our cash balance was down by about \$114,000,

which is nothing to be alarmed about he said. We are 25% through the year, revenues are at 25% and expenses are at 23%. The last page is an accounting of the Jaindl escrow account. The negative balance shown is only on paper as we did not pay the vendor until the account was replenished. He asked Jaindl to replenish the account and they did so promptly in the amount of \$19,594.53. So, the Jaindl escrow account has a healthy balance.

Not everyone had received the April report yet. Mr. Francisco said the cash balance is back to the positive by almost \$90,000. This was because we received payments from our users in the month of April.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

The Star Gazette is no longer publishing, so the Authority needs a second newspaper to receive notices of meetings.

Mr. Scott moved to adopt Resolution #20-24, to designate the Express Times (Warren County NJ Zone, if time allows) as the Authority's official newspaper, and the Star Ledger, as the two newspapers to receive notices of meetings. Concern was expressed about the increased cost. Mr. Tipton explained that there was no other newspaper in regular circulation in our area that we could use, and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-8.d, two newspapers are required to receive notices of meetings. (Laurel Napolitani entered the meeting at this time.) Mr. Should asked if posting on the website would meet the requirement? Mr. Tipton said the statute reads official "newspapers" and he felt this is where the legislature needs to fix this because it is archaic and costing towns and public entities extra money. Chairman Niece seconded the motion. All in favor, the motion carried.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Donati's report was included in the agenda packets.

Belvidere Climbing Screen: The design is almost complete. Mr. Donati presented a resolution authorizing filing the TWA permit application with the NJDEP.

Chairman Niece moved and Mr. Scott seconded, to adopt Resolution #20-25, granting authorization for filing the NJDEP Treatment Works Approval permit application for installation of a mechanically cleaned bar screen at the Belvidere WWTF. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Oxford UV Installation: The TWA has been approved by the DEP. Mr. Donati requested authorization to advertise for bids.

Mr. Scott moved and Ms. Napolitani seconded to allow CP Engineers to advertise for bids for the Oxford WWTP UV Project. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

AUTHORITY CONSULTANT

Mr. Shoudt's report was included in the agenda packets. He asked if there were any questions or did anyone want him to recap his report.

Belvidere STP: Chairman Niece asked about the effluent water system. Mr. Shoudt said there were problems with the effluent pump, so we are losing pressure at night.

There was a brief discussion about the Zoom meeting.

FINANCE

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #20-26 (Certificate No. 405: \$130,513.68) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund, as presented. Mr. Scott seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #20-27 (Certificate No. 412: \$12,907.75) be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvements Fund as presented. Mr. Scott seconded. The motion passed unanimously on roll call vote.

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #20-28 (Certificate No. 004: \$11,484.23) be approved to pay all bills from the Jaindl escrow account as presented. Mr. Scott seconded. The motion passed unanimously on roll call vote.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Scott moved, and Ms. Napolitani seconded that the meeting be adjourned. All in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 p.m.

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to install a mechanically cleaned bar screen within the Pretreatment Tank at the Belvidere Wastewater Treatment Facility (Belvidere WWTF); and

WHEREAS, the Authority's consulting engineer, CP Engineers, LLC has prepared the necessary engineering plans and specifications, as well as the necessary application documents; and

The Authority's consulting engineer, CP Engineers, LLC., is hereby authorized and directed to complete and file said Treatment Works Approval application and supporting documentation, along with a certified copy of this Resolution, to the NJDEP, and to request the necessary endorsement of this TWA Application from the local municipality.
