If you have not gotten a vaccination, here are some suggestions on getting one from the VA:

- 1) If you are enrolled in VA Western New York and been going to them on a regular basis: you can call your primary care clinic, the one in Niagara Falls, Lockport or the Buffalo hospital. Anyone who answers should be able to help you, just ask about vaccinations. The VA will call you back for the appointment. The VA is doing a great job with this, you are in and out in a half hour!
- 2) If you have fallen out of the system, or you were enrolled but have not been active in the last few years, you also can call your last primary care clinic for an appointment. This will be just for your COVID vaccination, if you want to get back into the VA system follow the next step.
- 3) If you are not in the system at all, you can call the Buffalo Veterans Services at the VA hospital at 716-862-8888. This applies to all Veterans with a DD214 who were honorably discharged. These people are not at the hospital; they are working from home at the present. Leave a message and a number where they can reach you, and please be patient. It may take a little bit of time for them to get back to you. If you don't hear from them in week call back.
- 4) I hope this works for you; if not give me a call, there may be other avenues to follow.

With that I will close for now and hope to see you at the March meeting. STAY SAFE!!
