

**Minutes of the Parish Council

90. **Chairman's opening remarks:**

The Chairman suggested that as Cllr Wickham had another meeting that evening that item 98 be discussed earlier in the meeting

91. **Apologies for absence:** None

92. **Declarations of interest:** Cllr King under 98

93. **Minutes of the last Parish Council meeting held on 10th August 2020** were noted and will be signed by the chairman at the next face-to-face meeting.

94. **Suspension of meeting for Unitary Councillor's reports**

94.1 Cllr King had nothing to report.

94.2 Cllr Wickham reported on the financial state of Wiltshire Council which despite press reports, the Council had brought down the shortfall due to covid 19 to around £5,000,000 with opportunity for the government to pay the Council for other services.

The meeting reconvened.

95. **Planning Applications received:**

95.1 20/06078/FUL – Agricultural Barn at Mayeford Stables

It was proposed that the Council object to this application due to lack of information and access. Proposed by Cllr Masson and seconded by Cllr Lock. Carried by majority

95.2 20/06584/FUL – New 8 bedroom accommodation at the Eaves

Actually part of North Bradley Parish. Creating 63 parking spaces, increase in traffic and access. The proposal was Support subject to conditions, which were concerns over increase of parking spaces and therefore increase in traffic and also access to the site.

Proposed by Cllr Masson and seconded by Cllr Youngs. Carried by majority.

95.3 No other applications received.

96. **Planning decisions made by Wiltshire Council since last meeting:**

No recent planning decisions have been received.

97. **Parish Clerk/RFOs Report**
97.1 The Clerk reported that there were only two Zoom invoices outstanding for £14.39 each.
97.2 The Clerk reported that he was not able to do a budget against actual spend as he was not able to find the actual budget on the parish council's laptop. Cllr Masson and the Clerk would deal with this during the following week.
97.3 The Clerk explained that the last two Clerks did not pay tax but he was over the threshold and recommended the Council use Keevil Accountancy to sort out PAYE. This was proposed by Cllr Masson and seconded by Cllr Thompson.
98. **Update with regard to developments at Northacre Renewable Energy including planning application 20/06775/WCM**
Cllr Masson outlined the Zoom meeting which took place with local MP Andrew Murrison the previous Thursday and included representatives from local Parish Councils and Westbury Town Council. Concerns had been voiced over traffic, health and retrograde system of waste management.
Cllr Masson outlined the traffic challenges. Cllr Wickham explained the system of waste management and contractual conditions. A member of the public stated that there would be residue which is toxic and which has to be transported away.
Cllr Morland stated that he is a member of other Councils considering the application. He explained waste from the present incinerator is hauled overseas but would be used in the new application.
Cllr Masson asked what should the Council submit to Wiltshire Council in respect to this application. He proposed that the Council object on the grounds of traffic and safety, especially increase in volume and environmental effects and agree to let Cllr Masson and the Clerk to word an appropriate reply. This was proposed by Cllr Masson and seconded by Cllr Lock. Carried by majority.
99. **Correspondence:** The Clerk stated there was no correspondence he had received that had not been passed on to the Councillors. However he mentioned that the two other Parishes he looked after received a lot more
Cllr Masson stated that he had a request from the Village Hall to move the meeting night. It was suggested the third Tuesday. However keep Zoom meetings at second Monday.
100. **Date of next meeting:** It was confirmed that the next meeting of Heywood Parish Council will be on Monday October 12th at 7.00 pm by Zoom.
101. **Matters for future consideration:** Cllr Thompson asked if there was any development with Glamping at Fullingbridge Farm. It was noted that the planning application notices had not been displayed. The Clerk was asked to write to planning department over this. It was noted that glamping site permission had been given to White Horse Country Park.

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
