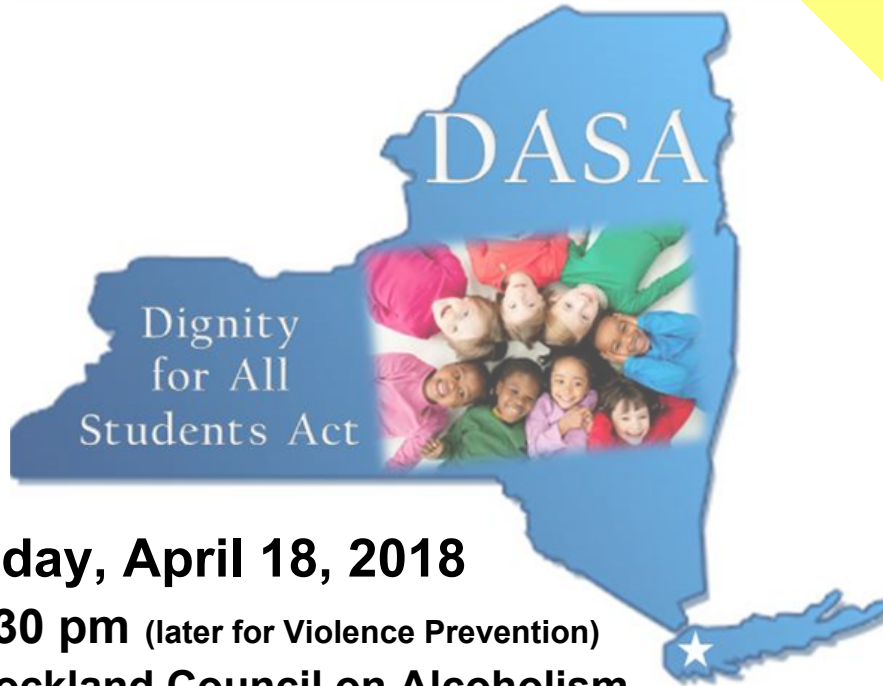

FAQS

What is DASA training? This 6 hour workshop meets the Dignity for All Students (DASA) training requirement of the NYS Education Department for state certification.

If I already hold state certification but am applying for a new certificate, do I need DASA training?

Yes.

Who needs to complete DASA training?

School professionals (teachers, paraprofessionals, counselors, psychologists and social workers) who are applying for state certification after December 2013 must take this 6 hour course. This includes members who are applying for new certificates (for example, paraprofessionals going from a Level 1 to a Level 2 or 3).

How will my attendance be recorded?

Proof of completion will be reported to your TEACH Account three weeks after the workshop is completed. You get a certificate on the day of the workshop.
