Secretary's Report: Minutes of the last meeting were accepted as published.

Treasurer's Report: Kathy Koehler had no report at this time, but a full report will be available after the May show.

OLD BUSINESS

PSSC May regional specialty Sunday 5/30/21

- Penny reported show entries were still open as of that day, but since there is a lower limit on entries this year she wasn't sure how much longer entries would be open. Show closes 5/12 or when full. Baray is the new show superintendent www.barayevents.com.
- No spectators or public are allowed. Only exhibitors and a few volunteers are admitted to show grounds.
- There is no grooming in the building. Groom at your vehicle or RV only.
- Shows are a show-n-go format. Exhibitors pick up their own armbands and any ribbons. Show catalogs will not be available for checking at the superintendent's table or ringside, but will be for sale.
- Some volunteers are needed for things like door attendants, filling hand sanitizers jugs, handing out food in hospitality room, clean-up, etc. Contact Penny about volunteering.
- Three (3) vendors are expected: 1 food, 1 general (Midwest), 1 scissors. They will set up in separate areas.
- There is no annual banquet on Sunday night. Unsure if any outdoor potluck gathering is allowed or planned.

Membership Letter and New Membership Chair

- Currently we have about 6 SSCA member names that are in or near our PSSC region, but not members of PSSC.
- Don Kachur has been working on a club letter to introduce PSSC to prospective members. He had remaining questions of who should be the signer of letter and the main contact person.
- During discussion, a motion was made to create a new Membership Chair position. This is a new position PSSC does not have. (*Sharon/Gwen*)
 - Don was nominated as the new chair. Vote passed.

NEW BUSINESS

SSCA Rescue requested help

- Lynne C was contacted by Debbie Casey of SSCA Rescue about a dog in Chicago, IL needing fostering and/or adoption. Details about the dog's situation were given. Potential fostering or adoption placements will be forwarded to SSCA Rescue.

New SSCA Zoom meeting account

- SSCA is setting up a new Zoom account for use if needed by the regional clubs. However, only 1 club meeting can be held at a time.
- PSSC could potentially use this new account if needed and if scheduling were not an issue.

Newsletter schedule

- Kathi Dvorak asked if she should stick to the regular schedule of our next newsletter. The schedule was thrown off due to this April meeting.
- Decision was the next newsletter should be as regularly scheduled – deadline June 7 with publication June 15. It will highlight our May show.

Other announcements/brags

- Three people told about recent successes with their dogs.
- Don't forget to send brags and photos to Kathi Dvorak for our newsletter and to Alexis Hubbard for posting on our PSSC Facebook page.
- Jon Rosenberg and Suzanne Garcia talked briefly about observations from shows they've been to recently, such as no shared catalog at ringside, bring your own pens, get your own arm bands, and signs sometimes confusing for ring entry/exit.

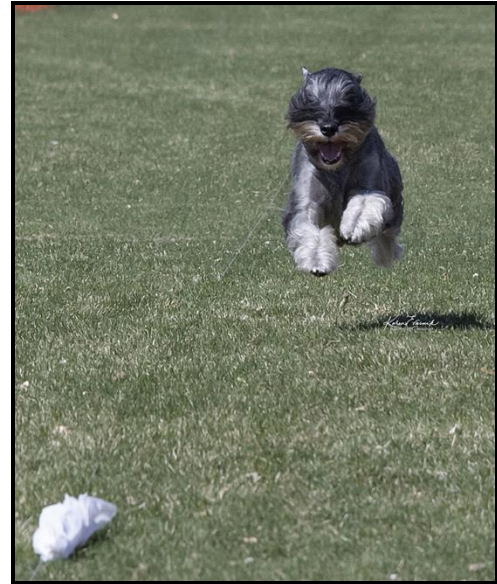
We had a wonderful time at the Prairieland local specialty in May! Thank you to everyone for all your hard work on the show. It was so great to see everyone.
