Due to the COVID and opening the office to the public, Sunday Collection will be counted on the 15th and 30th of each month only. Therefore, the totals will show a little different. The amounts above are from Direct Giving which was deposited on October 5th. You can call the office to get more information on Direct Giving. If you drop your envelopes at the office door, please ring the doorbell to notify Helen at the office that it is there so she can pick up immediately. **Please refrain from depositing at the office door outside of office hours.**

Recycling Fundraiser

Our recycling program is doing very well. If you wish to donate your beverage containers, you can do so by dropping your bags into the green bin next to the parish centre door. We ask that you drop off your recycling in this bin on Mondays if possible. This will give Gail time to bring the bags to the depot and get a report for the bulletin. Please remember this is for beverage containers only (pop cans, juice boxes, liquor bottles, beer bottles) not milk cartons, soup cans or plastic containers. We have again received bags of recycling with garbage and dangerous items in them. These bags were refused by the depot, therefore that revenue has been lost. Please be careful as to what you put in your recycling bags, The beverage containers must be cleaned and caps removed.
