The Season After Pentecost begins with the day after Pentecost and continues until Advent.

Red, a color of fire, is used on the Day of Pentecost and at other times when the work of the Holy Spirit is emphasized. Red is also used in evangelistic services, ordinations and consecrations, anniversaries and homecomings. Red is also used during Holy Week to symbolize the blood of Christ.
