Beginners Class 10 to 11 a.m. - Grades 1 to 6

• Students under Grade 3 accepted only after evaluation, having the ability to focus and work in a group lesson, and should have someone to practice and play with at home. There will also be homework that must be completed, and a Pawn Power manual to study, a quizzes and testing. Enrollment limited to 14 students.

• Beginning students in Grade 4 and above must pass tests and reach a rating criteria during this Spring Session in order to qualify to advance to the Fall Intermediate Advanced session starting September 14. Chess Newsletter provided to students.

Intermediate/Advanced 11:10 to 12:25 - Grades 4 to 10

• Experienced players under Grade 4 who have a Chess'n Math rating above 500 and tournament experience may qualify to join this class. Enrollment limited to 16 students. Chess Newsletter provided to students.

• All students in this class must already have a Chess'n Math rating above 500, unless they are junior or senior high and have shown at an evaluation that they know enough chess to play complete games and can fit into the class.

• All students in this class will be expected to play in at least one Spring or Summer Open Scholastic Tournament and are expected to show improvement through ratings, testing and completion of homework and assignments between Saturday classes.
