Martha F. Dronsella, 97, of Sebewaing, died Saturday, May 19, 2007, at Scheurer Hospital following a brief illness. She was born March 27, 1910 in Brookfield Township, daughter of the late Christian and Ernestine (Kurzer) Roemer. She was confirmed March 25, 1923 by R.A.D. Stoskoph at St. John Lutheran Church in Kilmanagh. She was united in marriage to John G. Dronsella on February 10, 1937 in Kilmanagh. He preceded her in death on September 23, 2001. Martha was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebewaing. She loved being outdoors gardening and in her flowers and she also enjoyed reading.
