



**THE FAIR FELLOWSHIP
ANNOUNCES ITS SIXTH FELLOW**

UCLA LAW GRADUATE SAIRAH BUDHWANI SELECTED

May 2019, San Francisco, CA - Legal Aid at Work (LAAW) and the California-based Foundation for Advocacy Inclusion and Resources (FAIR) announced the selection of Sairah Budhwani, a recent graduate of UCLA Law School, as the sixth FAIR Fellowship recipient.

They are a champion of workers' rights whose platform will expand during the FAIR fellowship. They have represented low- to no-income individuals at public benefits hearings as an advocate at the Urban Justice, and, during law school, enrolled in the Community Economic Development clinic, contributing to an organizational client's campaign on behalf of 12,000 misclassified port truck drivers.

FAIR will provide Budhwani's salary for the first six months of the year-long fellowship, when they will be with Legal Aid at Work. The second half of the fellowship will be spent with a firm affiliated with the California Employment Lawyers Association (CELA), an organization of more than 1,200 workers' rights advocates statewide.

FAIR is a California non-profit created by CELA leaders in 2009 to increase diversity in the plaintiffs' employment Bar and to raise public consciousness about workers' rights.
