## Sample Warm Up Prompts for Contextualization [or Thesis Writing] Warm Ups Linked to AMSCO chapters – Major Topics of Study

**NOTE:** In this document you will find one sample prompt for each chapter/topic. These prompts do not cover all of the content of the course. The purpose of this document is to give you a starting place to build your own collection. The potential topics in the right hand column can be used to help students begin the process of contextualizing if they are struggling to do so. Remember that contextualization is essentially setting the scene and explaining the broad context. It is not about defending an argument. The sample topics are relatively close to the parameters of the prompt. You can further challenge students by asking them to connect the historical significance of an event to a development in another era or even modern times.
