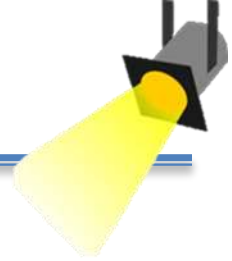

Memorandum of Understand: Eglin–Hurlburt Field–Gulf Coast Energy Network

For Background: This MOU between GCEN and EAFB's 96th Test Wing concerning the use of GCEN as a not-for-profit intermediary for developing and enhancing partnerships between and amongst EAFB and other public or private entities in the areas of research, education, training and installation support for sustainable energy programs, energy conservation measures (ECMs) and performance based contract initiatives. 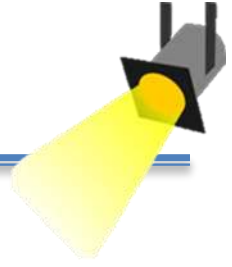

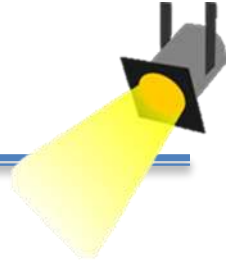
