

Memorandum of Understand: Eglin-Hurlburt Field-Gulf Coast Energy Network

For Background: This MOU between GCEN and EAFB's 96th Test Wing concerning the use of GCEN as a not-for-profit intermediary for developing and enhancing partnerships between and amongst EAFB and other public or private entities in the areas of research, education, training and installation support for sustainable energy programs, energy conservation measures (ECMs) and performance based contract initiatives. Status



- Working with FDEP to leverage VW Mitigation Trust Fund (\$166M) to evaluate the use of electric shuttle buses to address traffic concerns and reduce pollution.
- *Local Motors* has expressed an interest in participating in a demonstration.
- The shuttle buses are allelectric, 2/3 of the shuttle are made on a 3D printer.
- The shuttle buses are also fully autonomous.

- Working with the USACE and the City of Orlando to evaluate the potential to utilize stormwater ponds for solar PV. Good candidate for ESTCP.
