Program Descriptions

AGES: 3 -5 years (Semester programming)

Little Movers \$165.00/semester Mondays (ages 3-5)

This program is a joyful way for young children to explore movement through music, develop physical skills, channel energy, stimulate imagination and promote creativity. Little Movers is a way for children to know themselves and to see connections with the rest of the world. In this course students will learn musicality - counting and moving to different styles of music, while challenging their strength, stamina and flexibility.

Pre-Ballet \$165.00/semester Wednesdays (ages 3-5)

Pre-Ballet introduces ballet basics and inspires young dancers to express themselves through movement. Students are encouraged to challenge their balance, coordination and strength. Our instructor uses the Royal Academy of Dance to focus on form and technique which allows young children to enjoy dance and self-expression.

Littlest Drama \$165.00/semester Thursdays (ages 3-5)

Welcome to feisty game cravers everywhere! This very active and social community building group will experience over thirty different games to satisfy a love for physical entertainment. Fair play and sharing is required, developed and encouraged during physical play and during group decisions regarding game choices. This highly praised class focuses on fairytales and storytelling! Former students are welcome as new and different games are offered each semester.

Thematic Playtime \$165/ semester Fridays (ages 3-5)

This is a class for creative little people. This class includes drama games, storytelling, puppetry, crafts and imaginative exploration with a different theme each week! This is a great intro to drama course where we will explore our creative sides and learn how to express ourselves in different ways.

Little Tappers \$165/ semester Saturdays (ages 3-5)

This class will get your toes tappin'! Learn the basics of tap, and you can tap along to your favourite music!

AGES: 6 to 11 (full year programming)

Creative Movement \$325.00 Monday (ages 6-8)

This program is a progression of Little Movers, using principles of pre-modern, ballet and jazz dance styles. The children are asked to further develop their self-expression and creativity while learning more intricate steps and positions. Emphasis on synchronicity and working together as a 'team' is also introduced.

Ballet 1 \$325.00 Wednesdays (ages 6-8)

Ballet is the foundation of all dance and an essential part of any dancer's training. It adds grace strength, technique, and poise to a dancer's presentation. This program starts to teach ballet technique, positions and musicality appropriate to this stage of development. The children continue to learn story telling through movement, use of props and proper ballet technique in a fun and safe environment

Drama Fun \$325.00 Tuesdays (ages 6-8)

Explore what drama has to offer! This very active and social community building group will experience many aspects of drama including improv, acting, storytelling, puppetry, and imaginative exploration! Fair play and sharing is required, developed and encouraged during physical play and during group decisions regarding game choices.

Jazz & Lyrical \$325.00 Fridays (ages 6-8)

Learn how to groove with some awesome jazz moves! In addition to jazz, this class will also include learning how to dance lyrical (Kind of a jazz/ballet fusion).

Modern Moves \$325.00 Wednesday (ages 9-12)

Modern dance is a mix of modern and post-modern dance styles. The class will start with a warm-up that stresses technique, freedom of movement and full expression. Modern dance allows the mind and body to work outside the box.

Ages 6-11 Con't (Full year programming)

Ballet 2 \$325.00 Fridays (ages 9-12)

Ballet is the foundation of all dance and an essential part of any dancer's training. It adds grace strength, technique, and poise to a dancer's presentation. This program starts to teach ballet technique, positions and musicality appropriate to this stage of development. The children continue to learn story telling through movement, use of props and proper ballet technique in a fun and safe environment

Pre-teen Dance \$325.00 Wednesdays (ages 9-12)

Pre-teen dance will include learning ballet, lyrical, and jazz. Ballet is the foundation of dance and is an awesome skill to have to learn other styles of dance. Lyrical is kind of a jazz/ballet fusion, and jazz is an upbeat style of dance!

Musical Theatre 1 \$325.00 Tuesdays (ages 7-11)

Get a taste of what a musical is like with this program. Students will learn proper stretching, how to expand their flexibility; gain stage presence, how to incorporate singing while learning basic dance steps, and the confidence to perform! We will also explore basic acting skills that aid in the enhancement of a musical production.

Drama Jr. \$325.00 Tuesdays (ages 9-12)

This early introduction to theatre will explore many sides of drama. We will learn improv, storytelling, acting techniques, movement, a bit of creative writing and a taste of backstage work (set props and costumes, stage management). Games, scene work and story telling progressively encourage participation and the breaking of comfort levels in a safe and inviting arena!

Tricks, Flips, Clown and Masque 1 Thursdays (ages 7-11)

This is an active and movement based class. There will be some strength training included in this course to build up our muscles for some awesome tricks! We will explore different movement techniques used in theatre as well as flips, lifts and tricks. This course will also explore the basics of acro! We will also explore the basics of clown and masque which is a very physical skill used to find character!

AGES: 12 +

Teen Jazz & Lyrical \$325.00 Mondays (ages 12 and up)

Jazz embodies styles and techniques from ethnic and contemporary dance to ballet. Class will begin with stretching and toning exercises to prepare the body for the technique taught in class. Jazz classes are a great workout, and they're fun. All sorts of music – Broadway, Jazz, Pop, and Contemporary will be used in class.

Teen Ballet \$325.00 (ages 12 and up)

Have you ever wanted to try on those ballet slippers, but never had the chance? This program is designed for the beginner ballerina in all of us. Learn how to tendu, soule, and grande jete your way into the hearts of an audience! No previous ballet experience is necessary, just come with a strong work ethic and loads of enthusiasm!

Musical Theatre 2 \$325.00 Tuesdays (ages 12+)

Get a taste of what a musical is like with this program. Students will learn proper stretching, how to expand their flexibility; gain stage presence, how to incorporate singing while learning basic dance steps, and the confidence to perform! We will also explore basic acting skills that aid in the enhancement of a musical production.

Drama \$325.00 Thursdays (ages 12+)

Although this is the next level up from Jr Drama, we gladly welcome newbies! We will explore and heighten the same topics as the jr class but in a more detailed way (improv, acting techniques, movement, creative writing, storytelling, set props and costumes, stage managing). A great class to taste all that drama has to offer!

Ages 12+ Continued

Tricks, Flips, Clown and Masque Tuesdays \$375.00 (ages 12+)

This is an active and movement based class. There will be some strength training included in this course to build up our muscles for some awesome tricks! We will explore different movement techniques used in theatre as well as flips, lifts and tricks. This course will also include the basics of acro! We will also explore the basics of clown and masque which is a very physical skill used to find character!

Friday Drama Fridays \$325.00 (ages 12+)

This is a drama class offered for those students who don't have school on Fridays. We will explore the many facets of theatre; improv, acting techniques, character development, script analysis, creative writing, storytelling, and movement for the theatre.

Friday Musical Theatre Fridays (ages 12+)

A musical theatre class for those students who don't have school on Fridays. Musical theatre combines acting, singing and dance. These 3 elements will be explored in this class.

Friday Dance Friday \$325.00 (ages 12+)

Similar to Friday Drama, this dance class is also open to students who don't have school on Fridays. This is a dance class that will explore different styles of dance in one comprehensive class. Styles of dance include; ballet, jazz, lyrical, and contemporary!

Teen Tap Fridays \$325.00 (ages 12+)

Tap is known as percussion with your feet. Learn tap moves to tap along to your favourite music!

Other:

Mom and Me Storytime Dance (ages 2+)

This class infuses Storytime for children, with dance exercise for mom! This class will be offered during the day.

Adult Dance (ages 17+)

Have you always wanted to learn how to dance? Or maybe you have dance experience and would like a class to improve your skills. This is a fun dance class for adults. This class will explore ballet, jazz, lyrical, contemporary, with the potential of learning some tap!

Adult Drama (ages 17+)

Adult drama is a drama class just for adults! We welcome those with or without previous drama experience. This class will be mostly focused on improve skills, and depending on what the class wants acting techniques and script analysis.

Acro (ages 2+)

Depending on interest, we will offer acro classes for whichever age group desires it! Acrodance is a fusion of dance and acrobatics, including flips and lifts!
