

#### GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Brothers:

"Make us worthy **LORD** to serve those people throughout the world who Live & Die in poverty and hunger. Give them through our hands, the daily bread, and by our understanding love, give them peace and joy. **AMEN-** Saint Mother Teresa.

I had the honor and privilege this past Saturday, Aug. 19<sup>th</sup> to attend the 7:30PM mass at St. Anne's Church in Brentwood, as a member of Our Lady of Fatima 0716, 4th Degree Assembly's Honor Guard to escort and form the line of procession. The Mass was Celebrated by Cardinal Jose Gregorio Rosa Chavez (Archbishop of San Salvador) and Bishop John Barres and was part of 3 day tour of Long Island and the first visit from El Salvador to the United States for the Cardinal (an invitation from Bishop Barres). The mass was a traditional El Salvadorian Mass in Spanish, full of music and celebration. The Cardinal who will be 75 yrs old on Sep. 3<sup>rd</sup> was very gracious, humble and personable. Before the procession he walked up and down the aisle of the church shaking hands and saying hello to the parishioners. After the Mass began the Cardinal stopped for a few minutes to speak with the parishioners. He asked "who is from El Salvador?" Hands went up from most of the church. He then asked for hands of those who were from each of the individual cities of El Salvador. When he got to San Salvador again many hands went up and the Cardinal started to sing the National Anthem of El Salvador and the people joined him. During his homily Cardinal Chavez spoke out against the violence of MS-13, stating that this gang is putting a negative shadow over the El Salvadorian people who are "good family people". He also spoke directly to the parents and families of the teens who were killed by MS-13 in Brentwood & Central Islip. (Continued on page 8")



El Salvador' First Cardinal was a friend and a close collaborator of Blessed Oscar Romero, the fourth Archbishop of San Salvador, both have been very outspoken against poverty, social injustice, assassinations and torture. In 1980, Romero was assassinated while offering MASS in the chapel of the Hospital Of Divine Providence. In 1997, Pope John Paul II bestowed upon Romero the title of Servant of God, and a cause for beatification and canonization was opened for him. The cause stalled, but was reopened by Pope Benedict in 2012. He was declared a martyr by Pope Francis on 3 February 2015, paving the way for his beatification which took place on 23 May 2015.
