Dear Friends in Christ,

Surely there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off (Proverbs 23:18).

This month, I want to talk about how things are going, what I have doing, and what lies ahead. Each day, I am better acquainted with you all. Please be patient with me (and Caroline!) as we learn and remember faces and names – don't forget, there are only two of us, but over one hundred of you! Each Sunday is more comfortable than the last, and I am getting better in worship – I feel a more relaxed atmosphere each week. I am attempting to get to all the Sunday school classes, as well as the various meetings (important in our Presbyterian tradition!). Slowly but surely, I am learning "how things work" around here.

The ministry and outreach of MUP continues – our role as a "venue" for the community goes on, including the upcoming addition of *My School Preschool* this fall (more on that in future newsletters). I praise God that our building won't be empty during the week!

Needless to say, much work lies ahead. I've spoken with many of you, yet many remain. It is my hope to speak to anyone who wants to talk, including those who have stepped away from our fellowship. As I said my first week, nothing will happen at Mars UP until healing and reconciliation occur. If you would like to speak with me, please contact me to set aside a time.

Regarding the actual Interim process, we are a long way from the beginning the actual search. Before we get to that point, we will have many months of conversation, study, and prayer.

The first step will be to form a *Transition Team*. This is NOT the Pastor Nominating Committee, but a Team of 5 - 7 persons who will lead the congregation through the Interim Process. Elsewhere in this newsletter is an article describing the tasks and characteristics of the Team, and its members. Please take time to read the article, and pray about whom you might suggest to be on the Team.

My brothers sisters, in Christ, *Surely there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off.* I am absolutely hopeful, optimistic, determined, and *unafraid* of the future. With the help and support of the Holy Spirit, we WILL get through the days, weeks, and months ahead.

Please continue to pray for unity, dialogue, and reconciliation. Pray for each other, pray for whoever makes up the Transition Team, and pray for your PASTOR! I need all the help I can get!

I remain thankful to God for calling me to Interim Ministry, and to Mars UP Church for calling me as your pastor.

The Transition Team

The Transition Team helps organize and lead the Interim process.

The purpose of the Team is:

- To help members heal after the loss of the pastor and to gain perspective on the chapter in their lives that has ended
- To gather the feelings and ideas of both members and non-members of the congregation about their church in a time of change
- To provide a forum for the sharing and focusing of hopes and aspirations for the future
- To help the congregation move from preoccupation with the past to a state of readiness for a new chapter in their life under the leadership of a new pastor
- To involve the congregation in accomplishing the developmental tasks of the Interim period (Reflecting on our history, Discovering a new identity, Empowering and allowing leadership changes, Renewing denominational linkages, Committing to a new direction in ministry)

The Team members must be committed to the well-being and future of the congregation and its ministry. The congregation needs to gain perspective on the past and focus on the future. The goal is to bring the congregation to a condition of health, unity, and readiness to move forward under the leadership of a new pastor.

Communication between the Team and the congregation is crucial, and must take place on a regular basis. A liaison between the Team and session is a good idea (this can be one or two active elders.) Full support of the membership is essential to make the most of the Interim opportunity. The widest possible ownership of ideas and decisions must be sought.

The Team should be 5-7 members, and represent a cross-section of the congregation. It can be appointed by session (as compared to the PNC, which is elected by the congregation.) The members should have a vision of what should happen during the Interim process.

During the process, Team members need to exercise "appropriate behavior." They must value each member's contribution, and take all ideas and suggestions seriously. They must be willing to listen, and honor confidentiality. They must be willing to become acquainted with resources for gathering and evaluating information. The trust of the membership is essential.

A major task of the Team will be to gather information needed to create a congregational vision, establish goals, and define activities for the future ministry of the churches. This information will be a key resource for the PNC as they begin the search for the next pastor.

Expectations for Team Members:

- Must be diligent in the use of the means of grace and of prayer. This means regular worship attendance.
- Must be committed to helping fulfill the congregation's vision
- Must support the ministry of the congregation thru regular giving practicing good stewardship in the sharing of time, talent, and treasure.
- Must seek to grow his/her spiritual life by daily prayer and regular study of God's Word
- Must attend meetings and follow thru on assignments
- Must exhibit a spirit of cooperation and collaboration, willing to work together "for the common good" with staff and members
- Must seek to communicate clearly with other Team members, staff, and congregation members, and avoid misunderstandings
- Must respect the need for confidentiality in appropriate circumstances
- Must have the trust and respect of the congregation
