Please take a moment to review the following two items and publicize with all your members, coaches, team managers and administrators these rules and regulations which impact all member associations.

1. All USA Hockey registered teams which participate in non- sanctioned competition and events, including AAU, under the umbrella of their Mid AM Approved Association designation (Including use of Association name, team names, uniforms etc.) is subject to disciplinary action. **USA Hockey does not permit participation in any non-sanctioned Activities.**
2. Mid American District Hockey, Inc. adopted ADM cross ice at our Annual Meeting June 25, 2010 for implementation during the 2011/2012 season and the consensus of the affiliate members was to adopt cross ice at 8U, while allowing consideration for transition seasons of 2011/2012 and 2012/2013 which accommodated the 2003 and 2004 birth year participants. **Mid Am rule, since expiration of this "transition period", has been and continues to be 8U participants are cross ice which keeps Mid American District Hockey Affiliate in compliance with the USA Hockey ADM Program. Any deviation from this rule, within the boundaries of the Mid American District, subjects the local association to disciplinary action.**
