With the first words of Evening Prayer on Saturday evening, Holy Week began, and we are thrown into the dramatic final week of **Our Lord's** life. All week long, the Lord played a dangerous game of cat and mouse with the Scribes and Pharisees. He knew that he was meant to die on Good Friday, so that all would take place in accordance with the predictions made in the Scriptures, so he had to avoid the authorities, and only permit himself to be captured on Thursday evening. He took this last week of his life to make preparation for his ultimate sacrifice. This is how we, too, should employ this week. How will you make your final preparation for Easter?

- There are some instructions in the bulletin, so you can fold up your palm frond into the shape of a cross.
- The Chrism Mass is at the Cathedral in Crookston on Monday Evening at 6:30 p.m. All are encouraged to attend.
- There will be a Penance Service on Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. at St. Joseph's Church in Red Lake Falls.
- The Schedule of Services for the Sacred Triduum is inside this bulletin. If you have never come before, maybe this is the year to change that.
- F.Y.I.: The Easter Vigil is the only Easter Mass being offered in Oklee; there is no Mass in Oklee on Easter morning. If you cannot attend the Great and Holy Easter Vigil, you will be happily welcomed at one of our neighboring parishes on Easter morning.
