



We follow American Academy of Pediatrics & Centers for Disease Control Guidelines for vaccinations (subject to change) :

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| Newborn: | Hep B (if not given at birth) |
| 2 Months: | Pentacel, Prevnar-13, Rotateq, Hep B |
| 4 Months: | Pentacel, Prevnar-13, Rotateq |
| 6 Months: | Pentacel, Prevnar-13, Rotateq |
| 9 months: | Hep B |
| 12 Months: | MMR, Varivax, Hep A, <i>Hemoglobin Test</i> |
| 15 Months: | Pentacel, Prevnar-13 |
| 18 Months: | Hep A (only if 6 months since first dose) |
| 2 Years: | Hep A (only if 6 months since first dose) |
| 4 Years: | ProQuad, Quadracel |
| 10 Years: | Tdap |
| 11 Years: | Menactra, Gardasil |
| 16 Years+: | Menactra |
| 17 Years+: | Men B (Trumenba, 2 doses 6 months apart) |

Vaccine combinations:

| Proquad | = | MMR & Varicella |
