NEW LOCATION! THE RACE AND PACKET PICKUP WILL BE HELD AT THE GSU RAC PAVILION located at 3300 Old Register Road in Statesboro, Georgia.

- You can pick up your t-shirt and race packet at the GSU RAC Pavilion on:
 - Thursday, February 19th between 4-7 p.m.
 - Friday, February 20th between 4-7 p.m.
 - Saturday, February 21st between 7-8 a.m.
- The Kids Fun Run will begin at 8:00 a.m. and the 5K will begin at 8:30 a.m. Awards will be announced at 10:00 a.m.
