The NFWI Annual Meeting in 2025 will be held online. We are hoping to book a suitable venue where we can arrange a 'watch party' and further information will be sent to WIs about this next year. Observer tickets are available on a donation basis, with the recommended donation for individual tickets set at £5 and the recommended donation for group tickets set at £20. Link Delegates will receive a free ticket.

If it is your WI's turn to provide the Link Delegate please be aware that the Delegate will require a Wifi enabled device i.e. smart phone, ipad/tablet or laptop in order to vote on the Constitutional items during the meeting. It is essential that WI Link Delegate is tech savvy on this occasion.

Each online attendee will need to register to receive the link and Agenda to join. Further instructions and information surrounding registering for tickets will be communicated in due course.

Please see below the groups to which your WI belongs with regards to voting at the NFWI Annual Meeting. If your WI is at the top of the list (1) it is your WI's turn to send a Delegate, and you will represent the other WIs in your group. If there isn't anyone in your WI who would like to volunteer, please contact the WI next on the list (2) so that they may send a Delegate. This process should be continued if the 2nd WI does not want to send a Delegate; and so on. I would also advise the WI who is 2nd to contact the WI above them to check that they are sending a Delegate.

WIs (2), (3) and (4) should contact their Delegate and let her know how your WI would like to vote at the NFWI Annual Meeting.

Please be aware that it is the responsibility of the WIs in each group to communicate with each other and ensure that they have a Delegate, otherwise the Federation will allocate a Delegate. It is not the responsibility of the Federation Office to check with every WI as to whether they wish to send a Delegate.
