Presidents Letter

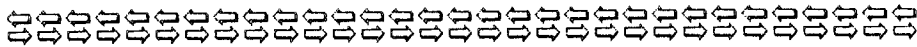

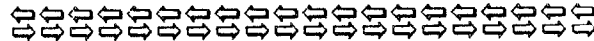
cards, skywriting and telegrams are eagerly accepted...

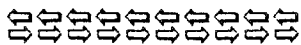

Games

Fox & Hound - here is a game to help hit those often elusive doubles. In this game, only doubles count.

This game is good for warming up or for shooting between matches since you don't have to write down any scores. This game is usually shot with just two players.

The general idea is to go all the way around the board hitting all the doubles along the way before your opponent does.

The winner of the middle picks a number to start on. He must then hit that double & then try for the double in the clockwise direction from there. Each player throws three darts each turn.

The second player begins at the double on the opposite side of the board that the first player started on. (if the first player starts on

d20, the other player starts on d3)

The first one to get back to the double they started on is the winner.

If one player catches the other before returning "home" it is a skunk.

Good luck Dayton as you travel the US.



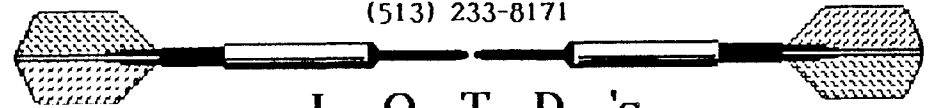

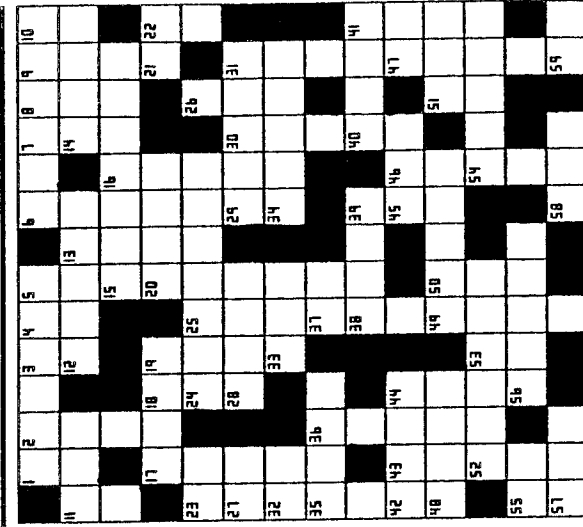
