60TH PEARL HARBOR DAY REMEMBRANCE

The City of Rockville joins the Fleet Reserve Association (FRA) Triangle 182 in remembrance of Pearl Harbor Day, December 7, 1941. The City honors the FRA's steadfast vigilance and deep commitment to the memory of those who were lost.

We pause to remember the 2,004 members of the United States Navy, 239 members of the United States Army, 111 members of the United States Marine Corps, and 58 civilians killed on that day. We also remember over 4,000 Marylanders who died during World War II.

Members of the U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, and U.S. Coast Guard showed courage and perseverance on that infamous day and onward. Veterans of these military branches in Rockville lived out the values of
