

Lehigh Riding Club 2021 COVID-19 Guidelines &
EHV Biosecurity Guidelines

Any existing CDC, State & or County procedures for outdoor, recreation facilities must be followed at all times

- 1. Everyone attending a 2021 Lehigh Show must fill out a COVID-19 Release Form**
 - a. To download and print this form: <http://www.lehighridingclub.com/forms.html>
 - b. This includes non-riders such as parents, guardians, trainers, volunteers, etc.
 - c. COVID-19 forms are available online. We ask that you please print them prior to the show to help us limit the number of people in and around our secretary stand
- 2. If you are able, please print off & fill out all show entry forms and releases prior to coming to the show. This helps us decrease the number of people entering our secretary stand**

- 3. Please no non-essential spectators**
 - a. Please limit the number of non-rider spectators such as trainers, parents, guardians to the absolute minimum
- 4. Please maintain proper social distancing (6 feet apart)**
- 5. Please social distance with the farm/family or group**
 - a. There will be no communal tent or gathering place. We ask that you socially distance appropriately with your farm group around your trailers
 - b. **We will not be providing our large tented area, so you are welcome to bring your own pop up tents. Space is limited. Tents MUST be secured! (stakes, zipties, etc)**
 - c. Please bring our own chairs also. No seating will be provided at this time
- 6. Please utilize hand washing stations and or use hand sanitizer**
- 7. Facial coverings are required in indoor spaces only—Secretary's Trailer**
- 8. Concessions will be available; we ask when purchasing concessions that you return to your appropriate socially distanced area to eat**
 - a. Please do not congregate around the food stand area
- 9. If you are sick DO NOT attend the show**
- 10. If you have exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last two weeks DO NOT attend show**
 - a. Symptoms include: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, fatigue, headache, etc.
- 11. If you have knowingly been exposed to a person who has contracted COVID-19 DO NOT attend show**
- 12. NEW FOR 2021: additional biosecurity measures/documentation required for each animal on premises**
 - a. Negative Coggins (up-to-date)
 - b. **Vaccination Record/Proof of Vaccination for EHV 1/4** (dose given within 180 days of show date)
 - c. **Self-Certification of Equine Health**

 - d. Please limit the contact between horses that are not housed together. We recommend that farms 'shelter' in pods together to prevent the comingling of horses. Another best practice is to not share (or limit sharing) of buckets, grooming tools, tack, etc. between horses.

- e. As always, if your horse is sick, has been sick, has been knowingly exposed to another sick horse please do not attend our show. Or if they are coughing, sneezing, have a fever or a nasal discharge do not attend. Obviously if your horse is displaying neurological symptoms do not attend.
- f. Please make sure you are aware of the symptoms of EHV/EHM: fever, loss of coordination, lethargy, ataxia, nasal discharge, hind end weakness, swollen lymph nodes, coughing, sneezing, incontinence, etc.
- g. MHSA recommends temperature checks for horses traveling in 2021—a fever is often one of the first symptoms to present

We ask that you please use your best discretion and common sense to help keep everyone safe and happy!
