Safe Environment (VIRTUS) Updates

The Catholic Church in the United States is committed to providing safe environment in all of our ministries and activities, especially those involving

children and youth. The Diocese of Jefferson City, in compliance with the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, requires all who work or volunteer in ministries or activities involving young people to complete a background check every five years. The background check database has been manually kept until just recently. The diocese is now utilizing an online date base to complete forms. If your background check has expired or is about to expire, you will receive an email from Virtus Online. It is important to follow the directions and fill out the form. You will be asked to print the form and mail it to Jefferson City (the information is all in the email). It is important that you do this as soon as you receive the email or you will not be able to continue to volunteer in our parish or school. Thank you for completing this process and helping us provide a safe environment for our children.
