

November 7, 2022

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:36 p.m., in the City Hall. Shawn Duevel, Elmer Boecker, Sandy Zierden, Kurt Thelen and Ron Doll were present.

On a motion by Kurt Thelen, seconded by Ron Doll and carried the minutes from October 3, 2022 were approved.

Fire Chief, Al Fiedler was absent. 1 Fire Call. 4 bills-I Am Responding, Al for reimbursement for chiefs trainings motel, Post Office Box, and Fireman's hours for the year.

Waste/Water Operator, Tom Valerius was present. Water was shut off at the park. Ran 2 profiles in town. Meter was turned backwards and was tampered with and the other was a running toilet. Waste water is all set up for the winter. Ponds 3 ½ feet first of November. Bills-Travel for sampling.

New Munich Jaycees—Donation to the park of \$3500.00.

Building Permits—Matt Goebel came to ask about adding a garage between house and existing garage. If all connected into one building it would be okay.

Steve Worms came to ask about narrowing the parking lanes when the road is redone and if the council can please talk to the county about this. How concrete are the plans and can they get the parking lanes to 12 feet and not 10 feet.

2022-2023 Snow Removal-discussed how the county will take care of the snow removal this year.

PFAS Monitoring Plan MOU-City need to decide to sign the MOU or not. After discussion and the first 2 samples are free and city has the option to cancel after that. Sandy Zierden made motion to sign the MOU and take advantage of the 2 free samples, Elmer Boecker 2nd, motion carried.

Council talked about issuing a fine to the rental house for tampering with the water meter of \$250.00 plus the cost of the water usage. Need to check with Susan to see if city is able to issue a fine. Council also discussed the leaking toilet and said they would not give a deduction to the leaking toilet as in the past residents have had to pay for this.

Council member Kurt Thelen looked into 4 electronics signs and they are priced at \$2800.00 each.
