January Cool Club Meeting Recap

We held our *"annual"* Club meeting at 'Cue Barbecue on Sunday, January 9th. We had a decent number of attendees, but far from what we should have. We had a half dozen or so report they were home sick and couldn't make it.

Those that attended were treated to an excellent 'Cue lunch with generous portions of friends and fellowship. We had two non-members, Jimmy Johnson & Larry Dodson, who both joined during the meeting. As a special treat, Sharon filled in for Rick, who was recovering from a loss of his voice, during the business meeting.

Below are some of the highlights from the meeting. Other news items can be found on page 5.

- Although we had another fantastic Toys for Tots campaign, we did have an "issue" with our Marines again this year. They left before the end of the show, plus they left a bunch of toys and had to come back the following week to get them. We are open to having a different group as our Toys for Tots group and are open to suggestions.
- Our first show for 2022 is at 'Cue on February 12th. We need volunteers and someone to pull the trailer. We could have an extremely large crowd, especially if we have good weather. We will need to utilize the same parking plan as for our Toys for Tots show.
- We will resume our show at the Hayes Dealerships in Baldwin this year after 2 years of COVID Cancellations. We will NOT need the trailer, but will need plenty of volunteers for setup (quick & easy), show car parking and working Registration and related duties.
- We need Sponsors for the new year. If you know someone interested in being a sponsor, please let us know; we also need Door Prizes for the coming year.
- We also rely on membership dues for our operating expenses. Please make sure you stay current. Annual dues are \$30 for email newsletter, \$40 for USPS delivery.
- We can ALWAYS use contributions from members for our Newsletter, including news items, reports on our shows and any items of interest to our members (including anyone that needs to be on our prayer list). It would also be nice to have someone help with photos during the show, as it sometimes gets extremely difficult to for Rick to get around the entire show field.
- We have discovered that the best way to advertise our shows is online. This is a MAJOR shift over the past few years from flyers. We advertise on our Facebook page, along with sharing the posts with a variety of FB pages dedicated to Car Shows in the North Georgia area. We also advertise on SoutheastWheelsEvents.com and Ragtops & Running Boards (printed/subscription only publication). We still hand out flyers at our shows and some local shows. We would like your help to promote our events, either electronically or via printed flyers. We will be happy to provide either electronic copies of our show flyers (PDF or JPEG format) or printed copies. If you want to hand out printed copies, please let us know how many copies you need and give us enough time to print them.
- We are starting the process of incorporating our Club and becoming a 501(c)3 Non Profit organization. This is in response to the new IRS policy to have online credit card services and payment services (PayPal, Square) to issue 1099 forms for all transactions over \$600 annually.
- As always, we are looking for more members for our "A-Team." We are happy to train you in any of the tasks that make-up our average show. We would like to have enough staff on-hand at every show that we can rotate members out for breaks, and time to enjoy the show. Please let us know of you would like to volunteer!



Our February Event Charity: It's The Journey



It's The Journey, Inc. – producer of the Georgia 2-Day Walk for Breast Cancer – is a local organization founded in 2002 by breast cancer survivor Randi Passoff. When the Avon 3-Day Breast Cancer Walk pulled out of Atlanta, Randi, a long-time walker, decided that Atlanta needed a fundraising event where all of the funds stayed local to support Georgia breast cancer patients and breast health programs. The mission of It's The Journey is to raise money to support Georgia breast health and breast cancer programs that focus on education, screening, diagnostics, support servic

es, genetic counseling and testing, research, and serving the unmet needs of the Georgia breast cancer community.

The 2-Day (30 mile) Walk is the flagship event of It's The Journey, Inc., and consists of a 20 mile walk on Saturday and a 10 mile walk on Sunday. Since 2002, the Georgia 2-Day Walk for Breast Cancer (formerly the Atlanta 2-Day Walk for Breast Cancer) has raised over \$17.5 million to fund 433 grants that provide breast cancer education, screening, early detection, support services, and continuing care for Georgians.

Sharon walks in memory of her Mom, Elaine, who died from breast cancer in 1990 at the age of 50, and for family and friends currently fighting breast cancer. Executive Director of It's the Journey, Stephanie, was diagnosed with breast cancer right after the 2-Day Walk last October, highlighting the need to keep fundraising until a cure is found.
