**ORDINANCE NO. 32**

An ordinance amending ordinance No. 26 licensing and regulating Malt Liquors.

The council of the Village of New Munich, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section I. That portion of ordinance No. 26 establishing the annual fee for on-sale license is hereby amended to read: The annual fee for on-sale license shall be one hundred dollars (100).

Section II. Closing hours shall be from 12 P.M. to 7 A.M. in all establishments handling non-intoxicating malt liquors or any other beverages.

Section III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Passed by the village council this 1st day of June, 1948.

**NOTICE**

To water consumers in the village of New Munich, Minnesota.
