

Wednesday is Residential Garbage Collection

TWO CANS OF GARBAGE PER HOUSEHOLD (not to exceed 18 kgs.)

VILLAGE EMPLOYEES WILL NOT PICK-UP EXTRA GARBAGE, it may be dropped off at the Public Works Yard for a minimum fee of \$4.50 (\$143/tonne).

The Public Works Drop Off Depot is open Wednesday through Sunday from 10:00 A.M.- 2:45 P.M. and is located on Hilke Road, past the ball fields. Materials must be separated & disposed in designated areas or additional fees may apply.

Garbage Depot Disposal Costs

\$143/tonne..... minimum charge of \$4.50

**MATERIALS MUST BE SEPARATED AND DISPOSED of APPROPRIATELY
In the DESIGNATED AREAS**

Solid Waste - General household garbage	\$143/tonne
Construction & Wood Waste - Construction waste must be kept separate from general solid waste; for example, gyproc would be considered solid waste.	\$143/tonne
White Goods - fridges, stoves, and other large appliances	\$5.00/ea.
Automobiles - rims and tires must be removed	\$25.00/ea.
Tires – based on weight with rims removed (Rims are free when put in metal bin)	\$4.50/min

The PUBLIC WORKS DROP-OFF DEPOT WILL CONTINUE TO HAVE AREAS AVAILABLE FOR THE FREE DISPOSAL OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:



- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Glass –broken, windows, picture glass, drinking glasses, dishes etc....
- ✓ Vehicle batteries
- ✓ Grass clippings, yard and garden pruning, up to 8" in diameter
- ✓ Paint & Product Care - various household paint products
- ✓ Fluorescent Lights & Lamp Recycling Program
- ✓ Household Batteries & Cell Phones
- ✓ Electro Recycling- Small appliance & power tool recycling (plugged in)
- ✓ Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarm Program
