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## **General Rules:**

- Entry must self-right from any position decoy will be placed in the tank on its back only two attempts will be made for it to self-right:
  - Swans do not have to self-right, geese and brant only from the side.
- Each entry must have an anchor attachment
- Entries may be entered in one class in the competition per year and not in that class in subsequent competitions
- No machine turned birds, or molded bodies or heads will be allowed in any Division
- All entries must be North American species
- No hybrid species will be allowed
- The Competition Chairman will be final authority for questions concerning any rules
- Only species listed on the registration form will be judged in each Division, other species will be placed in Bench Class
- Final judging will be 30 ft from tank
