

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2015-55**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-2015-13, REGARDING THE  
AUXILIARY POLICE UNIT IN AMELIA VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, In Ordinance O-2015-13, Village Council re-established the auxiliary police unit and established general rules for the auxiliary police unit; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to amend the general rules for the appointment and termination of auxiliary police officers.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** Section III of Ordinance No. 2015-13, is amended to read as follows:

There is created within the Village police department an auxiliary police unit, the members of which shall be appointed by the Mayor, and may be terminated by the Mayor. Auxiliary police officers are at-will employees and are not subject to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 737.19.

**SECTION II.** Section III of Ordinance No. 2015-13, which was enacted as follows, is hereby repealed in its entirety:

There is created within the Village police department an auxiliary police unit, the members of which shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the approval of a majority of Council. Auxiliary police officers may be terminated by the Mayor with consent of a majority of Council. Auxiliary police officers are at-will employees and are not subject to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 737.19.

**SECTION III.** All prior Resolutions or Ordinances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said Resolutions or ordinances not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION IV.** Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION V.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the urgent need to enable the Mayor to take necessary employment actions based on the

immediate requirements of the police department. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Mrs. Gerber moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

Mr. Campbell seconded the motion.
