School Responsibilities:

The Faculty of Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School will

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating students to meet academic and social standards
- Monitor student progress and provide instructional support throughout the academic year
- Hold parent-teacher conferences as it relates to the individual child's achievement
- Provide parents with reports of progress for your child
- Provide parents reasonable access to faculty members
- Faculty and support staff will be available to parents during events, such as: parent engagement nights, board meetings, workshops or upon parent request
- Provide parents with a clear communication protocol
- Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and be engaged in their child's education

Effective Communication Protocols:

In order to be able to achieve our vision and mission, the communication between faculty and parents is critical. We strongly encourage parents to contact faculty whenever a question, concern, or comment may arise. Our faculty communication to parents may take the form of newsletters, phone calls, emails, and special notes home.

The Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School asks parents to adhere to the following protocols for faculty/parent communication (faculty includes any instructional leader, teacher or support staff):

- Phone call/email to faculty stating question, comment or concern (allow 48 hours for response)
- If there is no resolution/response, contact administration via phone call/email (allow 48 hours for response)
- Contact the Executive Director if any of the above is not granted
- If the Executive Director does not respond/resolve question, comment or concern, the Charter Board will be informed immediately

The Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School believes that effective resolutions are handled when reflection and action is done through a team effort with all parties involved – the school does not entertain anonymous messages as it is important for the school to continuously engage in its community.

Defining our terms.

Code of Conduct – The Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School believes in the integrity, intellect and authenticity of each individual.

All individuals at the Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School believe that a positive school climate is important to a child's learning in the classroom and to his or her growth as a citizen. Each faculty member is responsible to maintain effective classroom management where individuals are not dehumanized.

The Chula Vista Learning Community Charter School goal is for students to learn from their mistakes, correct the behavior, and find positive solutions. Lessons and programs offered at our school foster positive social climate inside and outside of the classroom.

The Human element of empathy and social justice will be evident and validated for the reduction and prevention of institutionalized perceptions of deficit disciplinary problems.

The school's goal is to humanize the experience without deficit communication.
