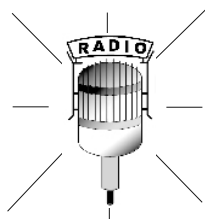

The 15 PROMISES of the Rosary from The Book "The Mysteries of the Rosary"
The Promises are presented in honor of the 28th Annual Rosary Congress October 6th - 12th

HISTORY

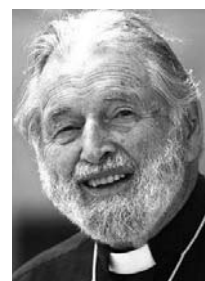
Alanus de Rupe (Alain de Ala Roche) was a 15th century Dominican preacher, best known for his efforts to promote the Rosary. Alanus claimed to have experienced a vision by which it was revealed to him that the Blessed Virgin Mary had appeared to St. Dominic and gave him the Rosary as a means to combat the **Albigensian** movement. Alanus de Rupe's revelation concerning St. Dominic and the Rosary was generally accepted until the 17th century when the Bollandists concluded that the account of Dominic's supposed apparition of **Our Lady of the Rosary** is not mentioned in any documents of the Church or Dominican Order prior to the accounts of Alanus over two hundred years later.

A popular prayer card listing the promises bears the **Imprimatur** ("let it be printed") of Patrick J. Hayes DD who was Archbishop of New York from 1919 to 1938. It was issued after a finding of "nihil obstat" (nothing obstructs) by an archdiocesan censor who reviewed the material to determine if it contradicted Catholic teach-

So, we called her "Mother Teresa of New Orleans." That was more than 15 years ago. She has been a busy lady.

ing. Neither a "nihil obstat" nor an "imprimatur" would necessarily reflect the personal opinion of either the censor or the archbishop regarding the document reviewed. Hayes' predecessor, John Cardinal Farley, issued an imprimatur for the edition of the Catholic Encyclopedia that holds the Rosary promises as not historical.

The 15 Promises fall under the category of "private revelation" from the Blessed Mother, and as such are a pious tradition, which a person is free to believe or not believe.

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall receive signal graces.
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
4. I will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the heart of men from the

love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.

5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.

6. Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its sacred mysteries, shall never be conquered and overwhelmed by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death (unprepared for heaven). The sinner shall convert. The just shall grow in grace and become worthy of eternal life.

7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.

8. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have, during their life and at their death, the light of God and the plenitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the saints in paradise.

9. I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.

10. The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in heaven.

11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the Rosary.

12. All those who propagate the holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.

13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of death.

14. All who recite the Rosary are my sons and daughters, and brothers and sisters of my only Son Jesus Christ.

15. Devotion of my Rosary is a great sign of predestination. ■

Part 33 CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

We are all missionary disciples Contd.

120. In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (cf. *Mt* 28:19). All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization,

and it would be insufficient to envisage a plan of evangelization to be carried out by professionals while the rest of the faithful would simply be passive recipients. The new evangelization calls for personal involvement on the part of each of the baptized. Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God's saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love. Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: we no longer say that we are "disciples" and "missionaries", but rather that we are always "missionary disciples." If we are not convinced, let us look at those first disciples, who, immediately after encountering the gaze of Jesus, went forth to proclaim him joyfully: "We have found the Messiah!" (*Jn* 1:41). The Samaritan woman became a missionary immediately after speaking with Jesus and many Samaritans come to believe in him "because of the woman's testimony" (*Jn* 4:39). So too, Saint Paul, after his encounter with Jesus Christ, "immediately proclaimed Jesus" (*Acts* 9:20; cf. 22:6-21). So what are we waiting for?

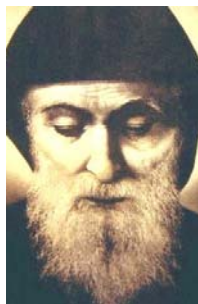
121. Of course, all of us are called to mature in our work as evangelizers. We want to have better training, a deepening love and a clearer witness to the Gospel. In this sense, we ought to let others be constantly evangelizing us. But this does not mean that we should postpone the evangelizing mission; rather, each of us should find ways to communicate Jesus wherever we are. All of us are called to offer others an explicit witness to the saving love of the Lord, who despite our imperfections offers us his closeness, his word and his strength, and gives meaning to our lives. In your heart you know that it is not the same to live without him; what you have come to realize, what has helped you to live and given you hope, is what you also need to communicate to others. Our falling short of perfection should be no excuse; on the contrary, mission is a constant stimulus not to remain mired in mediocrity but to continue growing. The witness of faith that each Christian is called to offer leads us to say with Saint Paul: "Not that I have already obtained this, or am already perfect; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own" (*Phil* 3:12-13).

Saint of Miracles

**Recent
Documented
Miracles**

The testimonies that are included in this writing are taken from the documented miracles recorded at St.

Maron's Monastery in Annaya, Lebanon where St. Sharbel lived, died, and is buried.

The first testimony is from Hassan Ali Fakih, a Muslim Shite gentleman with a wife and five children. Hassan is a native of southern Lebanon and was born in 1968. In his occupation as a foreman he suffered a fall and broke his ankle. The ankle was set and placed in a cast. After the removal of the cast he was still experiencing severe pain. An x-ray showed the bones were not set correctly. After spending five months in this situation his doctor told him that he might benefit from surgery, but the doctor only gave him a 10% chance for full recovery and the operation would cost Hassan approximately \$10,000! One of Hassan's co-workers was a devout Christian and suggested, "How about having surgery without paying any money, nor having any pain and surgical incision!" He responded, "How can this be?" The friend asked, "Do you believe?" And to that he replied, "Yes, I do!"

Hassan's friend went to Annaya and visited the shrine of St. Sharbel and prayed for him, asking St. Sharbel's intercession for healing. He lit a candle and brought another candle and blessed oil from the monastery. The friend instructed Hassan to light the candle as soon as he got home and to rub his foot with the oil before going to bed. Hassan

lit the candle and noticed a different sweet smell engulfing the whole house. Even his neighbors and relatives noted it. One of his clerics, an imam, (For Shite Muslims, an imam is central in defining their beliefs) came to examine this special candle, he even cut a piece of the thread and lit it without having any smell. When he lit the candle again the smell engulfed the whole house. The Muslim imam could not give him an explanation and found nothing wrong with the candle. Hassan continues saying that he put the holy oil on his foot as instructed by his Christian friend. Later in the night he woke up to go to the bathroom. As he opened his bedroom door he saw St. Sharbel in the hallway, he did not know him and was surprised. Hassan inquired, "Who are you?" St. Sharbel replied, "I am the blessing." (This was to help the Muslim understand him) When he tried to go near him, St. Sharbel disappeared. After he went to the bathroom he went back to sleep. His granddaughter's crying woke him the next morning. He states that he jumped out of bed to check on her, forgetting about himself and not even thinking of using his crutches. When his family saw him they started teasing him saying, "Where are your crutches? Why are you lying to us?" It was only then that he realized that he could walk and that he had no pain. He started banging his foot forcefully on the ground to make certain of his freedom from pain. He then went to the hospital and told the doctor what happened to him and that St. Sharbel had healed him. The doctor suggested an x-ray for his foot and volunteered to pay for it. The result showed that his foot was completely healed.

While Hassan was at the monastery with his Christian friend, St. Sharbel appeared to him again, this time at the office of Fr. Louis, the recorder of the miracles. St. Sharbel called Hassan to come to him. Hassan hugged him and St. Sharbel gave him a rosary telling him, 'Stay like this!' Now the Muslim goes and prays with people who are sick and takes the rosary with him.

The second testimony concerns a nine year old Christian girl named Jessy Emile Kanaan. Her mother states that Jessy suffered from bladder

and kidney disease for two years. The little girl was admitted to different hospitals for treatment and medical advice but Jessy's situation was worsening and she was headed for dialysis.

Jessy was due to have a bladder exam before starting dialysis, so the family decided to visit St. Sharbel's home in Bekaakafra to pray and ask his help. Jessy prayed and asked St. Sharbel to give her the blessing of healing from her kidney disease.

That night while they were asleep, the little girl saw St. Sharbel in her sleep around 4:00 a.m. She went to her father and woke him saying, "Open the door for St. Sharbel." Her father responded, "Go to sleep, Jessy. I will open the door tomorrow for St. Sharbel." After some time passed the little girl woke up her father again telling him, "Dad, no need to open the door anymore, St. Sharbel came to me and told me, "You are healed. You don't need to go to the doctor."

The following day the family took Jessy for her scheduled bladder exam. The doctor doing the exam was surprised and told the father that nothing was wrong! Jessy then told her father, "I told you, Dad, that St. Sharbel healed me and he told me not to go to the doctor. You did not believe me!"

When the doctor heard the child's statement, he responded, "I am not at the level of St. Sharbel. Bless his name. The bladder exam showed 100% normal. Your daughter is healed!"

The family went to thank St. Sharbel at Annaya and brought their medical report to register the miracle on September 14, 2017. The last miracle for this article concerns a Christian gentleman, Mr. Johnny Farid Yaqoub Sabo, who was born in Iraq in 1960 and resides in Michigan.

Johnny had a brain aneurysm and was bleeding from his eyes, ears, nose, and mouth. He entered St. John's Hospital in Michigan and they found a strong bleeding in the main artery that feeds into the brain. Johnny was treated quickly and

Have been house bound since last August, but now I am taking a few steps from my wheelchair each day. Thought I would never walk again.

then taken to Johann Royalook Hospital to undergo a mandatory surgery for the bleeding artery. The surgery was to be difficult and dangerous.

Johnny began praying to St. Sharbel asking his intercession with the Lord Jesus Christ and asked that the surgery be done by St. Sharbel himself. At night, St. Sharbel appeared to him and said, "I am coming to operate on you in the name of the Lord." St. Sharbel began the operation and Johnny saw and felt St. Sharbel's hand enter his head and work inside his skull. In the morning the surgeon came to operate on him, but Johnny told the doctor, "St. Sharbel has visited me and he did the surgery."
