- Assemble their own Creality3D Ender-3 Pro 3D printer
- Learn how to use their 3D printer to print various 3D objects
- Learn how to use Cura software to prepare 3D prints
- Learn where to find 3D print files for use with their printers
- Learn how to create their own 3D print projects
- Print several 3D objects
- Take home their own Creality3D Ender-3 Pro 3D printer



3D printing is time consuming with most prints taking a couple hours to complete. Some more complex prints may require an overnight print session, or in some instances over 24 hours of continuous printing. At camp we will focus on the shorter prints so that each camper will be able to take home at least one project per day.

3D printing is not an exact science and as such not all prints will be successful. While this is frustrating, the goal is to learn to trouble shoot why a print failed and try again. 3D printing takes patience and time, but can be very rewarding when a successful print is complete. Printed objects can be just for fun or useful.
