

Performing Companies-Rubies, Sapphire, Emeralds, Diamond Dazzlers and Hip Hop Crew Dress Code

Attire: Company Dancers are required to wear their “company attire” (team top and black leggings or pants) during company jazz technique class and rehearsals. Leotards and tights are required for ballet. Dance shorts may be worn over leotards in ballet class. Dancers may wear any form-fitting dance clothing for lyrical, hip hop, tap or trio/solo rehearsals.

Hair: Hair should always be pulled into a neat ponytail or bun. Flyaway hairs or long bangs should be secured out of the face with bobby pins or a snug headband. Dancers should have their hair up before entering the classroom.

Shoes: Company dancers are required to have tan and black jazz shoes. Tan jazz shoes should be worn in rehearsals. Leather split sole ballet shoes are required for ballet class. Sneakers should be worn for hip hop class. Ballet shoes or bare feet can be worn for lyrical/contemporary class. Black leather lace up tap shoes for tap class. Bare feet are used for tumbling/acro.
