Only one (1) storage shed is allowed per lot. If you have two sheds, you will be asked to remove one of them. The maximum size allowed is 10' x 16' and requires a completed application for Permit at the management office as well as Charlotte County.

Residents must maintain their shed in an excellent exterior appearance - free from rust, mold, mildew or other unsightly appearance. Please refer to Article 7.26 of the 2nd Amended and Restated Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions.

Multiple HOA's will meet on the evening of July 18, 2019. There is not a pin-pointed time for any particular MSBU, so you should plan to bring a drink and/or snack and be patient. We are told there will be room for everyone. The proposed increase to \$350 (as noticed in the June 18th letter) is to provide a reserve for future paving, completion of the current pipe lining program as well as the current maintenance program. After consideration of public comments, the Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners will consider imposing the assessment. If the assessment is adopted, the increase will appear on your 2019 ad valorem tax bill.

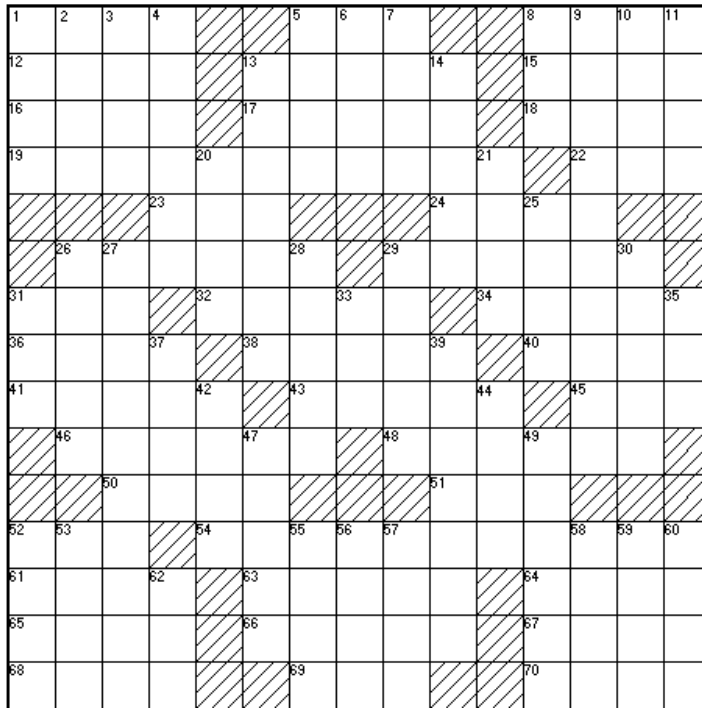

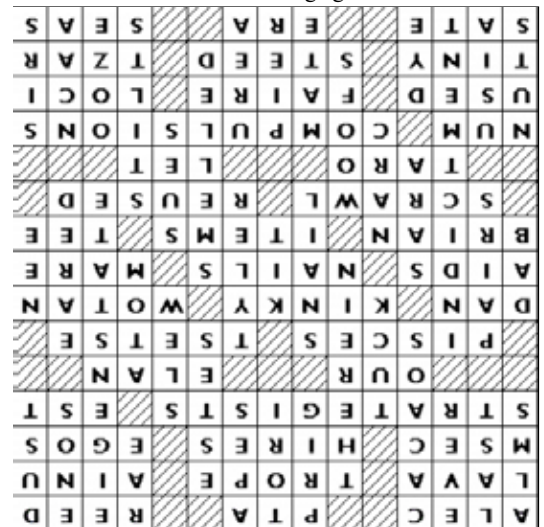

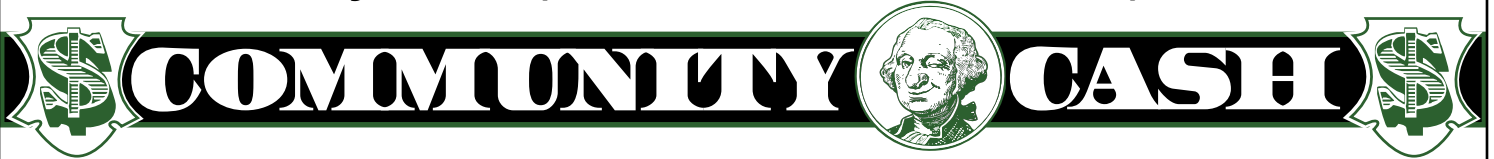
