






Transportation is provided between 8:30 AM - 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Dial-A-Ride travels to all locations in Vernon, Ellington and Tolland including medical appointments, shopping, social and recreational. Whenever possible grocery and other shopping trips are provided on a group basis.</p> <p>To make reservations, call (860) 870-7940, Monday – Thursday 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM, Friday between 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM. Reservations can be made in advance, on a first come first serve basis. The minimum amount of time to make a reservation is one week in advance of the appointment.</p> <p>This schedule excludes holidays.</p> <p>Cost - A \$2.00 donation will be needed when boarding the van on each trip. Round trip costs \$4.00. You must have the exact amount as the drivers will not have change.</p>
