Buckles Awarded to Show High Point Categories: Overall Open, Overall Amateur, Overall Intermediate, Overall Novice, Overall Green Horse, Overall Youth, Overall Cowpoke (see eligibility below).

Class Ribbons to 4th Place

OVERALL SERIES HIGH POINT SADDLE to be awarded on Sunday, August 16, 2020, to the highest scoring Division horse/rider combination from both shows. If entering more than one division, the Rider must declare which Division will count for the Overall Series High Point Saddle prior to entering their first class.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Mountain Trail will have a minimum of 10 trail obstacles on the mountain trail course and may require gait transitions and maneuvers that may normally be performed while trail riding or during an obstacle competition. The horse should move quietly and willingly as it would in any pleasure or working situation. Obstacles may include bridges, water crossing, gates, ditches, hills, planks or other obstacles you could encounter.

Ranch Trail will have a minimum 10 natural ranch type obstacles on the mountain trail course and may require gait transitions and maneuvers that would normally be performed while on a working ranch. The horse should move naturally forward and willingly, as it would in a real working environment. Obstacles may include cows, bridges, water crossings, gates, ditches, hills and step-ups.

Freestyle Ranch Riding is a pattern class in which the rider and horse are judged on being natural and efficient as if they were working on a ranch. Patterns will have 5 mandatory elements and 5 optional elements of the rider's choice which will consist of transitions and maneuvers that would normally be performed while in a working ranch situation. Rider will present their pattern and element order to gate person prior to entering the gate. The horse should move naturally forward and willingly, as it would in a real working environment.

Ranch Riding is a pattern class which will be the same for all divisions. The pattern will be provided to all participants.

Timed & Judged is a judged obstacle class. Times are awarded points to be added to judge's score for a final score.

Never Won a Buckle Class – Open to any exhibitor in the Novice or Intermediate division that has never won a buckle in any trail competition. A buckle will be awarded to the highest scoring horse/rider combination in the three Never Won a Buckle Classes.

MBS/BCM Buckle Class – Open to all exhibitors. A buckle will be awarded to the highest scoring horse/rider combination in the three MBS/BCM Buckle Classes. Buckles awarded separately for the MBS & BCM events.

DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS:

Open Rider - Open to all exhibitors

Amateur Rider - Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses/mules, not to have received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a clinic or seminar.

Intermediate Rider - Any exhibitor not eligible for Novice Rider, but has not won more than 2 class championships (weekend, event or series championships) at any trail competition.

Novice Rider - Any exhibitor who has not won first place three (3) times in any trail competition.

Green Horse - Any horse being shown for the 1st year.

Youth - Exhibitor 17 & Under who has not received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses/mules.

Cowpoke – Any horse or rider who has not won a first place in any trail competition and in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Intended for beginner trail horses and riders. Course patterns will be different than Show/Series High Point classes.

SHOW HIGH POINT AWARDS: Buckles will be awarded to the highest scoring horse/rider in each division at each show.

OVERALL AWARDS ELIGABILITY: Must attend and compete in both Ranch Trail Shows (Maxson-Box Stables & BC Mello), and compete in all Division classes to be eligible Saddle Award. The Overall High Point Series Saddle will be awarded to highest scoring Division horse/rider combination from both shows. If entering more than one division, the Rider must declare which Division will count for the Overall Series High Point Saddle prior to entering their first class.

BC MELLO/MAXSON-BOX RANCH TRAIL SERIES

General Rules & Guidelines:

- U Must attend both Ranch Trail Shows (Maxson-Box Stables & BC Mello), and compete in all Division classes to be eligible for the Overall High Point Saddle Award.
- U Full payment must accompany the entry form for each show. Exhibitors must enter at least one class and pay all applicable fees. Failure to do so may result in being charged a post entry/late fee.
- U Open checks are a courtesy to exhibitors entering classes at each show. Full payment is due with original entry per show.
- U \$10 office fee per registration
- U Pre-registration deadline must be postmarked by July 14, 2020
- U \$10 late fee for registrations after July 14, 2020
- U Management may combine, split or cancel classes with less than three (3) entries
- U No Class Refunds will be considered without a Physician and/or Veterinary Note
- U No Refunds for missed classes
- U Daily course maps and patterns will be posted each morning at the course walk thru and information briefing
- U Abuse of any horse or animal will not be tolerated and offender will be disqualified with no refund
- U Western tack required, riding boots, long pants, long sleeve shirt, western hat or helmet
- U No training devices allowed (martingales, tie downs, etc.) Bosals or Hackamores are permitted
- U Judge or management decisions are final
- U Riders will be judged at each obstacle with 3 refusals per obstacle at judge's discretion
- U Stallions welcome for adult riders only. Please place a yellow ribbon in forelock and tail
- U Helmets required on all riders 17 & Under.
- U All dogs must be kept on a leash and in the dry camping area. Absolutely no dogs near or on the courses or arenas at any time.
- U Please use lower entrance to trail courses and arenas. No horses in upper barn or house area.
- U All ages based on age as of 01/01/2020
- U CONDUCT: Exhibitors, Trainers, Owners, Owner's Representatives, Spectators, and all other persons present on the show grounds shall be orderly, responsible, sportsmanlike and humane in the treatment of horses. Unsportsmanlike or irresponsible conduct or any other form of misconduct that is illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating, threatening, harassing, or abusive is prohibited, as is the inhumane treatment of horses. Show Management may immediately expel offenders from the show grounds, forfeiting all prizes and awards with no refund of fees paid. Show Management reserves the right to reject any entry of any Exhibitor or Owner, or the participation of any Agent, Representative or Trainer, who has shown an objectionable attitude towards the Show and/or its Management, or who has conducted themselves in an abusive, irresponsible, or unsportsmanlike manner at a previous show.

COURTESY ITEMS

- U Full payment must accompany the entry form for each show. Exhibitors must enter at least one class and pay all applicable fees. Failure to do so may result in being charged a post entry/late fee.
- U Open checks are a courtesy to exhibitors entering classes at each show. Full payment is due with original entry per show.
- U Dry camping in field next to the pens.
- U Please adhere to quiet times - 10pm to 6am.
- U Please clean your pen before leaving
- U Water is limited
 - o Please do not rinse or wash horses
 - o Please turn water off at faucet after using
- U All dogs must be kept in trailer/camping area
 - o Dogs must be contained at all times
 - o Please clean up after your dog
- U Please use lower entrance to trail courses and arenas. No horses in upper barn or house area.
- U Please Pack it in, Pack it Out
- U All participants are welcome to arrive Wednesday, August 12, 2020, after 1 PM.
