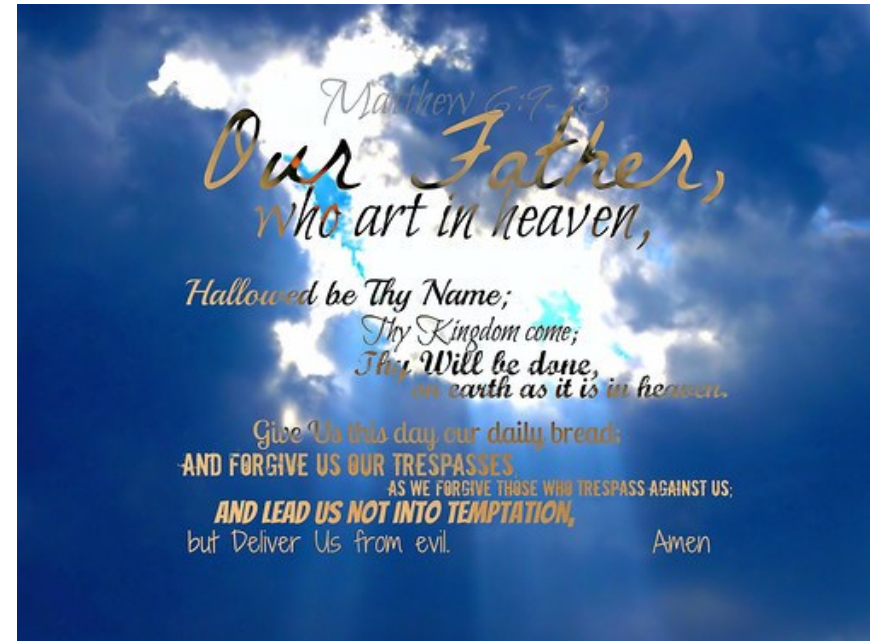

Recipe of the Month

Amish Peanut Butter Pie

1–9” Pie Crust, baked & cooled

1) Peanut Butter Crumbles:

1/2 C. Powdered Sugar

1/4 C. Creamy Peanut Butter

Mix until crumbles. Add 1/2 of the mixture to bottom of pie crust.

2) Pie Filling:

3 oz. Box Instant Vanilla Pudding

1 1/2 C. Milk

1/2 C. Creamy Peanut Butter

1 C. Cool Whip

Mix pudding, milk, and peanut butter for 2 minutes. Add Cool Whip—mix lightly. Pour into prepared crust. Top with 2 C. Cool Whip. Sprinkle with remaining crumble mixture. Refrigerate 1-2 hours.

My family requests this pie for every holiday dinner.



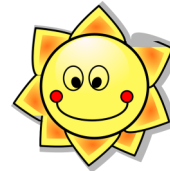
