- Discharge firearm at or into Habitation or School Safety
- .04 Ever convicted or charges with an Offense of Violence ORC 2901.01 or an offense, other than a traffic offense, under an existing or former municipal ordinance or law of this or any other state or the United States, committed purposely or knowingly, and involving physical harm to persons or a risk of serious physical harm to persons. This includes any conspiracy or attempt to commit, or complicity in committing, any offense of violence.
- .05 If applicant has been convicted or has been adjudicated a delinquent child under the following offenses within 5 years. 2 or more assaults or 2 or more negligent assaults.
- .06 If applicant has been convicted or has been adjudicated a delinquent child under the following offenses within 1 year. Resisting arrest.
- .07 If applicant is or has been: Adjudicated mentally incompetent, committed to any mental institution, been found court to be a mentally ill person, subject hospitalization by court order, or an involuntarily patient other than for purposes of observation.
- .08 The person is drug dependent, in danger of drug dependence. Or a chronic alcoholic.
- .09 If applicant is subject to any temporary protection order or civil protection order in Ohio or any other state.
