

RULE 42 CASES

All cases apply to events held under RRS with no further changes in the Sailing Instructions

Case 1

You judge a Laser event. Race Committee displayed Oscar flag together with the warning signal.
What rules apply?
What do you do if you see a boat sculling at the start?

Case 2

You judge a 470 event. Race Committee displayed Oscar flag together with the preparatory signal.
What rules apply?
What do you do if you see a boat pumping at the start?

Case 3

You judge a Finn event. Race Committee displayed Oscar flag together with the warning signal.
What do you do if you see a boat sculling at the start?
What do you do if you see a boat rocking downwind?
What's the wind speed limit for the Finn class?

Case 4

You penalized a boat for pumping on the reach. The boat took a penalty. After the race you find out that the race was held under Oscar flag that for some reason you missed.
Is the boat entitled to redress?

Case 5

You penalized a boat for rocking. It was her first penalty. The boat started the penalty on starboard, tacked, gybed, tacked and continued racing on port.
What action, if any, do you take?

Case 6

You penalized a boat in a second race of the day. The boat took Two-Turns penalty. When making yellow flags summary ashore you find out that it was the boat's second penalty. What action, if any, do you take?

Case 7

You penalized two boats at the start for sculling. They started taking the penalty turns nearly at the same time. In your opinion one of them, boat X, missed one gybe. After seeing results ashore boat X lodges a request for redress.

Is the boat entitled to redress?

What would you do if it turned out that boat X took her penalty correctly?

Case 8

You penalize a boat for sculling at the start. It is her second penalty. Just after the start RC signals general recall.

Can the boat start in the repeated start?

What force does the penalty you imposed have?

Case 9

RC displays flag Romeo at the top mark. You see a boat pumping when fetching the mark. The boat stops pumping once she passed the mark.

What action do you take?

Case 10

RC displays flag Romeo at the top mark for 470 class. In your opinion the wind speed is still

exceeding the limit and it is an improper action of the RC. After passing the top mark you see one of the boats pumping.

What action, if any, do you take?

What's the wind speed limit for 470 class?

Case 11

You penalized boat X for the third time. She retired from the race. Before the finish of the race RC abandons it due to lack of wind.

Can boat X start in the restarted race?

Case 12

You see an Optimist boat sculling at the start. You whistle but due to the mess at the starting line you cannot identify the boat and point a flag. Shortly after, you lose a sight of that boat.

What action, if any, do you take?

Case 13

You penalize a Laser during the race. A boat takes a penalty. Ashore you check the sail numbers with the flags you have given and it turns out the number you have does not exist.

What action, if any, do you take?

Case 14

You see a boat pushing from another boat at the start to have better position at the line. At the same time a helmsman of that boat is loudly and undecently cursing at another sailor.

What action, if any, do you take?

Case 15

You see a boat colliding with a mark and stuck at it. A sailor is using his hand to get clear of the mark.

What action, if any, do you take?
