In *Psalm 103:2*, David is encouraging himself when he says, "*Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits* ..." There are so many men among you, who are still there doing their time, and others who have gone on to see their parole who God used to help shape and mold me for what He is doing in my life even now! So, I for one thank God for D.O.C. and all that He was able to do in and through my life while I had to be there.

The Word says we are to redeem the time because the days are evil. God has afforded us the luxury of sparing our lives and separating us from our environment and setting us apart so that we might hear His voice. I know I'm not the only man/woman among us who has heard His voice calling in their lives. The calling is from God, the blessing is found in the

I have friends that love me and a wonderful job. I'm blessed with cars, 2 Harley Davidson motorcycles and the little things that give me joy. But the most important thing He has blessed me with is the opportunity to be a witness to the life changing power of Jesus Christ, before men! Love to you all in Christ, AND MERRY CHRISTMAS!!

My people are dying, getting old and everything else, I just want to be with them. So, please pray for my situation and have everyone you can pray for me also. Well, since being in the hole, I have been reading my Bible and reading a book by Charles Stanley, I want so badly to be back living in righteousness for the Lord. Well, an old Tennessee boy needs prayer. Also, I have a friend named Alexander who is struggling with some issues, so have everyone pray for him and my family. I want to thank you all for your service and dedication to the Lord ... J.T.

I have a very desperate prayer request. My mom is 88 years old and the only family I have. I am 58 now. I have been given a large sentence. My mom is desperately trying to talk to the governor. Her testimony will set me free. My case is not on appeal because out of fear I took a plea. But if she can get through to the governor I might be able to go home. Please pray that we receive a breakthrough. I know what the Lord has for me to do upon release. Without a miracle from God, I will not be released. Please put me on your prayer request. I am so afraid but I know God is not the God of fear. Ole satan is really tormenting me daily. I need your prayers so much. I won't give up. Thank you so much ... J.M.

I ask you to keep me and my family in your prayers for restoration, peace, and health ... A.G.

Please keep me in your prayers to stay on the right path! Please pray for my mother's hands and feet. She is 70 years old and still works at Fry's store. She is a very Christian lady ... J.M.

I ask for prayer for my granddaughter, she has a sickness that they are not taking into consideration. I saw her and she had a spell so she was taken to medical but they don't know what is wrong with her. Please pray for her ... M.G.

This is by far the worst yard that I have been on. Lots of negative people, lots of drugs, and all the stuff that goes along with them. Please pray for me and ask God to make this last year go fast. Can't wait to see you guys face-to-face. God bless you all ... M.S. Praise Reports

God has truly blessed me this month. I have received two letters from my sister who I haven't heard from in over a year. I was really glad to hear from her. She's the one person in my family that I am close to and due to various health issues, I worry about her a lot. She's 363 days younger than I am. So for two days every year we're the same age. HA!HA! Pretty crazy ... Foot

First of all, sorry for my writing, but I'm writing with a stick. We do not have pencil or pens herein the hole. I'm writing about your newsletter I received, at a time of need. I was on suicide watch because my momma just passed of cancer, and I was going through a lot. My whole life stopped, after

that I stopped getting mail, money, and pictures, that's important here in jail. So, like I said, "I was done with life." But out of nowhere I received a newsletter on June 8th, how did that happen because: 1) I couldn't receive mail because I was on suicide watch, but they gave it to me anyway; 2) The address on the newsletter is wrong, it says Oklahoma City, OK and I'm in West Virginia; and 3) I didn't ask for the newsletter, but thank God for it and Mrs. Michelle, Mr. John and

the rest of your team of people. When I got the July newsletter, the address was still wrong, but I'm not on suicide watch anymore. I'm in the hole waiting transfer to another jail. But I said to myself, "God is trying to tell me something, and He

used Mr. Duck and the A-team to tell me." .... D.S.

Say brother \$Cash\$, It was great to get your card with the kind inspiring words! I will remember you and your unique name. I can hardly wait to turn off of Lindsey Rd. and onto Brown Rd. then I'll be like 3/4 of a mile from my favorite church, Living Word Bible Church. You all run a great service there at Living Word and I'll never forget a Valentine's Day in 2013 when I was there. Your church offers free child care after the evening service, so that the parents can have what they call 'Date Night'. This service allows those that attend

the evening service to leave their children there at the church where they're also fed while the couples go and have an evening together without the children. That's their vision, building strong homes and families. Boy, if only I'd listened to my heart instead of my messed up mind at that time! But you know what? My relationship with our God is better NOW than ever before. Let me tell a 'funny' story. I'm working at an animal shelter six days a week and praise God the weeks are flying by. So anyway, I'm digging in my box of old mail looking for one of the cards you all had sent me. Reason being, for some reason I'd stopped getting the newsletters and so wanted to receive them again. All of a sudden POW! BOOM! BANG! I find one of your newsletters and then not even four minutes pass and what do you know ... another NEW newsletter came sliding under my door! Boy GOD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME ... K.P.

First, I want to thank you all there at the Overconces for Efinist for your thoughtfulness in the remembrance of my birthday. The contribution you all extend to the community of believers is humbling. Your vision to reach out to the lost and the saved are not going unnoticed.

I have been incarcerated almost 11 years. I was convicted of second degree murder. The Lord has shown much grace to me over the years of my life, yes, even when I was in darkness. I'm sure you've heard the saying, "You can lead a horse to water, but you can't make him drink." Well, an addition was added that says, "Though you can't make him drink, when he thirsts he will know where to go to get some water." Likewise, God's Word NEVER returns void, but WILL ALWAYS accomplish its purpose wherever He has sent it. The words He gave you are being sown for His Kingdom. Some seeds bring forth its fruit sooner than others, glory to God the harvest is coming!

Listen to one of the amazing truths I read today in Colossians 1:22 (NIV), "But now He has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation." As I read this the word "now" lifted my spirit. Its pretense and the phrase "in His sight" caused me to shout! Right NOW God sees me holy, blameless and above reproach because of Jesus. The freedom to know that God sees me this way is not because I don't sin, BUT because of what was done to Jesus on my behalf.

There are so many of you brothers and sisters out there that struggle in your flesh. And we who have been set free from certain struggles of the flesh, let 'us' help the others to see that their 'righteousness and grace' is secured in Christ so that they may receive and KNOW the revelation of His grace and love has ALREADY set them free as well.

I found that when I tried to do what God's Word said, I was focused on obedience to the law of God. Now let me explain what I mean by all of this:

When I say, "I can only plant the seeds" what I mean by that is sharing the Word of God with people, telling them about the love of Jesus, that's my job and spiritual maturity in God will increase.

When I say, "I can tend the soil," means I can be checking up on a brother/sister, spend time with him/her, relating with him/her and reading the Word of God with them.

When I say, "Let my light discourage the weeds" means I remember what the Bible tells me, "Don't put a lamp under a table, or a city on a hill cannot be hidden." The way that I see it is, by me spending quality time with a new brother/sister, negative people may stay away from them. THE POWER OF GOD IS REAL!

When I say, "Let the conduct of my walk poison the worms," means I'm saying the worms of doubt will eat the plant and kill it. But when a new brother sees me, an ex-gangbanger, walking upright and with peace and love he then gains confidence and before long he can begin to do it to.

When I say, "I don't wait for the rain" means that I know I need to put in more effort and believe me I need to work on that. That could be as simple as walking up to a random brother (or sister) and saying, "Jesus loves you." I do that but I know I need to do more. Inviting them to meetings is the putting in work part for me. And when I see a new brother backslide or give up instead of getting hurt or mad, cause it will hurt, that's where I just give that pain to God.

At the end I define my walk. The "No need for pesticides" are the unnatural things that help plants grow. Just like when we see brothers (or sisters) feel temporary joy from drugs or drinking they may give you temporary joy but that too is short lived as it all begins to turn unhealthy.

## Glory Gifts By M.G.

Let me fill you with My love, joy, and peace. These are glory gifts, flowing from My living Presence. Though you are an earthly vessel, I designed you to be filled with heavenly contents. Your weakness is not a deterrent to being filled with My Spirit! On the contrary, it provides an opportunity for My power to shine forth more brightly.

# Foot's Bible Study Rotes

# 2 Kings 9:14-10:31

Peace, properly understood, comes from God. It is not genuine except when rooted in belief in God and love for Him. Don't seek peace and friendship with those who are enemies of the good and the true. Lasting peace can come only from knowing God who gives it to us. (9:18-19)

We are to be completely intolerant of sin and remove it from our lives. We should be tolerant of people who hold differing views, but we should not condone beliefs or practices that lead people away from God. (10:24)

# Acts 16:16-17:34

Paul and Silas were stripped, beaten, and placed in stocks in the inner cell. Despite this dismal situation, they praised God, praying and singing as the other prisoners listened. No matter what our circumstances, we should praise God. Others may come to Christ because of our example. (16:22-25)

You may not receive much attention (in fact, you may receive only grief) for your service for Christ. But God wants to use you. Lives will be changed because of your courage and faithfulness. (17:6)

Today, we have a "Christian" society, but to most people, God is still unknown, we need to proclaim who He is and make clear what He did for everyone through His Son, Jesus Christ. We cannot assume that even religious people around us truly know Jesus or understand the importance of faith in Him. (17:23)

# Psalm 143:1-144:15

David was losing hope, caught in paralyzing fear and deep depression. At times, we feel caught in deepening depression and are unable to pull ourselves out. At those times, we can come to the Lord and, like David, express our true feelings. Then we will find help as we remember His works (143:5), reach out to Him in prayer (143:6), trust Him (143:8), and seek to do His will (143:10).

David's prayer was to be taught to do God's will, not his own. A prayer for guidance is self-centered if it does not recognize God's power to redirect our life. Asking God to restructure our priorities awakens our minds and stirs our will. (143:10)

Because life is short, live for God while you have the time. Don't waste your life by selecting an inferior purpose that has no lasting value. Only God can make your life worthwhile, purposeful, and meaningful. (144:3-4)

# Proverbs 17:26-28

This proverb tells us that it is wrong for believers to be fined or punished for being good and honest. What kind of message does that send if we get into trouble every time we obey God? That's a terrible thing. (17:26)

This proverb highlights several benefits of keeping quiet: 1) It is the best policy if you have nothing worthwhile to say. 2) It allows the opportunity to listen and learn. 3) It gives you something in common with those who are wiser.

So that when you do speak, you will have something important to say. (17:27-28)

Circumstances and situations ... we all know too well that left to our own devices these can spin out of control too fast and more times than not we let our circumstances and situations control our lives.

What we need to do is trust in God, because God is the only One Who can change circumstances and situations. What we can change is our perception of our circumstances or situations, because no matter what we're going through it could be worse. It's all about perception.
