Arko x Dee Dee Legacy:

Bigrock Vom Foreman, son of Dena Vom Ferronhaus (BDC-UFTA legedary champion and daughter of ArkoxDeeDee) won the BDC-UFTA World Championship in November for owner Bernie Birkenholtz of Wisc. Foreman's litter sister, Halli vom Ferronhaus 's 4 mo old Minni vom Ferronhaus puppy placed 3rd in the open dog competition in NC BDC-UFTA trial in Nov for owner Matt Behe. This was her first trial and since there is no class for puppies under 10 months, she ran in the open class with the big dogs which included the number 5 dog in the nation in 2009, which she smoked. She completed her 3 bird run in just under 5 minutes and according to Matt, she would have won the entire match in just over 3 mins if he hadn't have had to get on his knees and beg her to bring him her last bird! This litter is the result of close line breeding of Halli (gr da of ArkoxDeeDee) to Levi(son of Arko,gr son of Coal, grt gr son of Audi). This litter traces to Trixie Vom Pregelufer(mother of Zobel v Pregelufer) 5 times in the fifth generation and 2 times in the 6th generation. I think I hit a home run with this mating. Austin Vom Ferronhaus has his two majors and now just needs a few singles to finish his champion. This was done with limited showing by Christin. Austin won the Indy specialty and was res to 5 pt majors at both the Michigan speciality(his first time in the ring) and the Wisconsin specialty.


